


Connector Assembly Drawing

Connection on Underside of Desk



Insert one end of the AUX cable into the AUX hole of the module and the other end into the 3.5mm headphone hole of the mobile phone to play the sound of the mobile phone through the product.



Insert the USB flash drive into this hole, the system will automatically identify the MP3 file and automatically play.

This USB port can charge the phone.

Important – Safety - Only use the power adaptor supplied.



Desktop Keys



Bluetooth mode

On initial power up, the desk will automatically default to Bluetooth mode. Allow Bluetooth pairing on your mobile device and select 'Koble' from the list of available devices. Once pairing is successful, an audible beep will be heard. To disconnect Bluetooth, press and hold the '() 'key for 3 seconds.

Note - The desk can only be paired with one device at a time. To connect to a different device, first disconnect from the original device, then begin a new pairing with the new device.


AUX mode

Press the ' 'key on the desk top to switch to AUX mode. Connect the AUX cable to the port on the underside of the desk and the other end to your music playback device (3.5mm headphone jack). Use your playback device to control music playback through the desk speakers. In the AUX mode, the desktop keys cannot be used to control music playback.

USB mode

Insert a USB flash drive with MP3 files into the music reading USB port on the underside of the desk. It will automatically recognise and play songs in MP3 format.

USB Charging

- *Please connect correctly with type C and the USB charger with desk.

Wireless Charging (Magsafe)

If you have a wireless charging compatible device, please put the phone on the wireless charging indicator and check if the phone is successfully connected to the charging function. If not, move the mobile phone near the logo until the connection is successful.

Some phone cases may inhibit the wireless charging function or it's efficiency. It may be necessary to remove the phone case if difficulties are experienced.





No power display	Power plug not inserted properly. There is no power in the socket. The power is not switched on.	The jack must be electrical. Press the plug. Turn on the power.	
No sound	Audio sound cable not properly connected. The volume was set to the minimum.	Connect the audio sound cable correctly. Set the volume to normal standard.	
No high or low sound	High / low volume set to minimum.	Set the volume to normal standard.	
No wireless charging	Power not connected. Mobile device does not have wireless charging function.	Check power is connected and on. Check your mobile device has wireless charging capability. Remove device case.

Important Safety Instructions
