



HOW TO REROLL AND PACK THE BRIMSTONE EV FIRE SUPPRESSOR BLANKET

THESE INSTRUCTIONS APPLY TO BOTH THE STANDARD
AND XL EV FIRE SUPPRESSOR BLANKETS.

Our EV Fire Suppressor Blankets may be used multiple times for training (as long as they have not been used to suppress a fire). Because of our innovative quick deployment process, after you use a blanket for training, it is important to reroll and pack it correctly to ensure proper deployment in an emergency. Do NOT skip this step.


BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- This rerolling and packing process requires two people. A third person is not necessary, but may help to speed up the process.
- Please note that the material in this EV blanket contains fiberglass. Wear appropriate protection when handling, as minor skin irritation may occur without it.


PREPARE THE AREA AND THE BLANKET

- You will need an area with a flat surface that is large enough to accommodate the size of the unfolded blanket.
- Ensure the surface of the area is clean and dry.
- Spread the blanket out and ensure that it is also clean and dry prior to beginning the folding process.

The blanket has two longer sides and two shorter sides. Position two people opposite each other on the longer sides and near the corner. If you have a third person, position him or her at the centerline of the shorter side.



ACCORDION FOLD THE BLANKET



Identify the existing crease lines on the blanket (which should be approximately 25" apart). Or you may place tape on the ground to mark 25" from the corner of the blanket on the longer sides. Then, with both people working in unison, begin the accordion-fold process by placing your hand (that is closest to the corner) on the blanket at the first crease line or the 25" mark.



With your other hand, grasp the blanket edge at the next (or second) crease line and pull it toward the corner of the blanket. Each portion of the accordion fold should be 25" wide.



Repeat this process until the entire length of the blanket is accordion folded. Between each fold, be sure to check the position of the fold at the center of the blanket.



The last fold on the top should match the width of the other folds. If the last fold is more than 4" wider, turn the blanket over (as the first fold will be properly aligned).

THE CORNER HANDLES



After the blanket is folded, tuck the bottom corner handles (orange) into the first fold.



On each end, ensure the topmost corner handles are exposed.




Access to these handles is important in the emergency quick deployment process.

THE QUICK DEPLOYMENT / CINCH STRAP



Position the center of the quick deployment / cinch strap at the centerline of the blanket and extend the strap a few inches beyond each end of the blanket.



Loop the strap ends back toward the center. Both ends of the strap should overlap at the centerline of the blanket.

ROLL THE BLANKET



Reposition each person at opposite ends of the blanket. Ensure the topmost orange corner handles are under the quick deployment / cinch strap. Then, working in unison, begin to tightly roll each end of the blanket toward the middle. Be sure the strap is inside the roll.



After the blanket is rolled a few times, pull each loose end of strap and lay it backward over its portion of rolled blanket. Continue rolling each end toward the center of the blanket while keeping the top strap tight and centered on the roll.




The placement of the top strap is important in the emergency quick deployment process.



Both rolls should meet in the middle of the blanket with the reflective centerline showing.

THE EXTENDABLE POLES



Two extendable poles are included with the XL blanket kit and are optional for the standard blanket kit.



If poles are present with your kit, place them under the quick deployment / cinch strap that is located between the two blanket rolls. Align the top of the poles (the end with the carabiner) with the top of the blanket (which is the edge showing the reflective centerline).

PACK THE BLANKET



Identify the top of the blanket as the edge with the reflective centerline and the top of the bag as the edge with the Center on Threat arrow.

At this point, the blanket should be fully rolled. For demonstration purposes, it is pictured slightly unrolled to show the centerline reflector location and how it should align with the arrow at the top of the bag.



Open the bag (carrying case) and place the double-rolled blanket (with poles, if applicable) lengthwise inside of the bag, ensuring that the exposed rolls are facing up and that the top of the rolled blanket is facing the same direction as the top of the bag.



Ensure that each loose end of the strap is lying over its respective blanket roll. Then, tuck each loose end between the outside of the roll and the inside of the bag.



This will ensure that each strap is positioned correctly for quick deployment in an emergency.

FINAL STEPS



Zip the bag closed, ensuring that the zippers meet in the middle of the bag.



This will aid in quick deployment in an emergency.

Then, insert the instruction card into the clear vinyl pouch with the front of the card facing up.

Store your EV blanket kit in an appropriate, dry location for easy access during an emergency.

When to discard the EV blanket:

Since this EV blanket is designed for a single fire event, after it has been used to suppress a lithium-ion battery fire, do NOT reuse the blanket. Instead, dispose of it in accordance with local and federal regulations and order a replacement blanket immediately.
