Materials

- 1 skein Lace Weight Silk Sparkle Yarn
- US B/2.25 mm Crochet Hook
- 2 Small Open Jump Rings (not included)
- 2 Ear Wire Findings (not included)
- Jewelry Pliers (not included)
- Scissors and Tapestry Needle (not included)

Abbreviations

CH: Chain

SC: Single Crochet

HDC: Half Double Crochet

DC: Double Crochet **SL ST:** Slip Stitch

Pattern Notes

- Finished Dimensions: Length from the hook to the bottom edge of the tree: 2"
- Gauge: 4x4 Square = 10 ST(S) x 10 Rows of HDC
- The tree is made up of three half-granny square style pieces. You will make each individually, then sew together using yarn needle before blocking.
- Make 2 of each size triangle so as to make a set of earrings.



PATTERN

Top Triangle (Smallest): BEGIN WITH MAGIC RING.

- 1) Ch 4 then work 3 DC into magic ring. Ch. 3 then work three more DC into magic ring. Ch 1 then work one more DC into ring. Ch. 1 / turn

- 2) HDC 3x in first ch 1 space (last ch 1 from previous round). Ch. 1, hdc 3x into Ch3 space from previous round, ch 3 then work 3 more hdc into same space. Ch 1 then hdc 3x into last ch 1 space. Finish off leaving 5 in tail.

Middle Triangle: BEGIN WITH MAGIC RING.

Ch 4 then work 3 DC into magic ring. Ch. 3 then work 3 more DC into magic ring. Ch 1 then work one more DC into ring. Ch. 2 / turn

—Hint: Again, I go ahead and pull the ring tight(ish) at this point so that I see what I'm working with.



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2) DC 3x in first ch 1 space (last ch 1 from previous round). Ch 1, dc 3x into Ch.3 space from previous round, ch 3 then work 3 more dc into same space. Ch 1 then dc 3x into last ch 1 space. Hdc 1x into same space. Finish off leaving 5 inch tail

Bottom Triangle:

Ch 4 then work 3 dc into magic ring. Ch 3 then work three more dc into magic ring. Ch 1 then work one more dc into ring. Ch. 3 / turn

—Hint: I go ahead and pull the ring tight(ish) at this point so that I see what I'm working with.

Dc 3x in first ch 1 space. Ch 1; dc 3x into Ch 3 space from previous round, ch 3 then work 3 more dc into same space; ch 1 then dc 3x into last ch 1 space. Work one more dc into same space. Ch 1 / turn

Hdc 3x in between first 2 dc (last 2 dc from previous

round). Ch 1, hdc 3x into next ch 1 space; ch 1 then work 3 hdc in ch 3 space from previous round; ch 3 and hdc 3 more times into same space; ch 1, hdc 3x in next ch 1 space; ch 1, hdc 3x between last 2 dc; Work one more hdc into same space. Finish off leaving 5 in tail.

Construction:

Connect the three triangles—smallest to largest, tip of triangle to bottom of triangle above—using tapestry needle and the tails from each to sew the pieces together. Weave in/trim ends when done.

Next, attach jump ring to tip of tree, and the jump ring to the earring finder. Use jewelry pliers to close jump ring.

Block if desired.
