## EARLY SPRING SCARF



### **Materials:**

- •1 Skein Darn Good Twist Lace Weight Silk Yarn (Crocodile Snap)
- US 6 (4 mm) Straight Knitting Needles (not included)
- Tapestry Needle (not included)
- Scissors (not included)

### **Pattern Notes:**

Finished Size:

Approximately 6.5 x 48 inches

Want to make a cowl instead? Save a yard of yarn to sew the scarf ends together. Voila!

### **Abbreviations:**

**K**: knit **P**: purl

**ST(S)**: stitch(es) **YO**: Yarn Over

**K2TOG**: Knit Two Together

## Pattern:

Cast On 24 STS

**Row 1:** K2. \*YO, K2TOG\*, repeat between \*'s until two stitches remain. K2.

Row 2: Purl Entire Row.

**Row 3:** K2. \*K2TOG, YO\*, repeat between \*'s until two stitches remain. K2.

Row 4: Purl Entire Row.

**Repeat** Rows 1-4 until desired length is reached, or one yard of yarn remains.

Bind Off and weave in ends. Enjoy!

# EARLY SPRING SCARF



#### **Materials:**

- •1 Skein Darn Good Twist Lace Weight Silk Yarn (Crocodile Snap)
- •US G/6 (4 mm) Crochet Hook (not included)
- Tapestry Needle (not included)
- Scissors (not included)

### **Pattern Notes:**

Finished Size:

Approximately 5 x 40 inches

## **Abbreviations:**

CH: Chain

**SC**: Single Crochet

**ST(S)**: Stitch(es)

**DC**: Double Crochet

**SK**: Skip

## Pattern:

CH 26 STS

Row 1: Turn. CH1 SC into every stitch.

Row 2: Turn. CH4. DC into 7th CH from hook (see ^). DC

in next stitch. \*CH2. SK2. DC in next stitch. DC in next


stitch.\* Repeat between \*'s until end of row.

Repeat Row 2 until desired length, or one yard of yarn

remains.

Last Row: Turn. CH1. SC into every stitch.

Fasten Off and weave in ends. Enjoy!
