

EASY BREEZY TOP

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PROJECT DETAILS:

Skill Level: Easy

Craft: Crochet

MATERIALS:

Hook: US J/10 / 6 mm

Yarn: Darn Good Yarn: DK Weight Herbal Dyed
Recycled Silk Yarn Pack - Maine Coastline

Other: Measuring Tape, Tapestry Needle, Scissors,
Blocking Materials (mat, pins, spray bottle)

ABBREVIATIONS:

ST(S): Stitch(es)

CH(S): Chain(s)

DC: Double Crochet

Yarn A: Pink

Yarn B: Taupe

Yarn C: Lightest Blue

Yarn D: Medium Blue

Yarn E: Dark Blue

PROJECT NOTES:

- The pattern is written for size small with the other sizes in parentheses as follows S(M, L, XL).
- The garment is worked from the top down starting with the mesh stitches and the lightest color of yarn.
- At the beginning of the mesh stitch rows the turning chain counts as 1 ch space. To create the mesh stitch you will be crocheting into the chain spaces rather than the top of the chain stitches from the previous row.

MEASUREMENTS + GAUGE INSTRUCTIONS:

Small: (Fits Bust size 32-34")

Top Width =14.25" Bottom Width =18" Length =23"

Medium: (Fits Bust size 36-38")

Top Width =16" Bottom Width =20" Length =23"

Large: (Fits Bust size 40-42")

Top Width = 17" Bottom Width =22" Length =24"

Extra Large: (Fits Bust size 44-46")

Top Width = 18.75" Bottom Width =24" Length = 24"

Mesh Stitch Gauge: 14 sts x 8 rows = 4" square

- Gauge swatch pattern for the Mesh Stitch.

CH 20

Row 1: 1 dc in the 5th ch from the hook,

(the skipped ch counts as 1 ch space) [ch 1, skip 1 ch,
1 dc in the next ch] repeat across, turn. (17sts)

Rows 2-10: ch 4(counts as 1 ch space), skip first dc, [1 dc
in next ch space, ch 1, skip 1 dc] repeat across, the last dc
will be worked in the turning ch space, turn. (17sts)
