FRENCH HEN SHAWL

KNIT PATTERN

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SKILL: EASY

MATERIALS NEEDED

- 3 Skeins Silk Roving Worsted Weight (225 yds)
- US Size 8 (5 mm) Knitting Needles (not included)
- Scissors (not included)
- Darning Needle (not included)

GAUGE

• 4" x 4" = 22 sts x 17 rows in granite stitch pattern

PATTERN NOTES

- In this pattern you will learn the granite stitch which is a fun four-row repeat. Total 4 sts increased after each repeat.
- Creates Shawl Approx. 16" x 50"
- This shawl can be styled with a casual outfit or with a dressy formal outfit!

ABBREVIATIONS

K: Knit

P: Purl

St(s): Stitch(es)

K2tog: Knit 2 together

KFB: Knit the front and back of a stitch

PATTERN

Cast on 4 sts

Row 1 (Right side): Knit to last stitch, yarn over, KFB.

Row 2 (Wrong side): Yarn over. K2tog across.

Row 3 (Right side): KFB across.

Row 4 (Wrong side): Yarn over. Purl to last 2 stitches, K2tog.

After knitting these four rows, simply repeat the pattern until your piece is the length you desire and enough yarn remains to bind off. End on Row 2 and bind off. Cut yarn leaving a 6 in. tail and weave in the ends. Block to desired dimensions.
