

La Vie En Rose Headband

Knit Pattern

by Darn Good Yarn



SKILL: ADVANCED

Materials Needed:

- 1 50g skein of DK Weight Herbal Dyed Recycled Silk Yarn
- 5 mm knitting needles
- Button
- Tapestry needle and scissors

Pattern Notes:

- Gauge: 12 stitches x 10 rows = 3.5 x 2 inches
- Finished Dimensions: Approximately 3.5 inches wide by 19 inches long (before edges are attached with button)
- Pattern can be adjusted to removing or adding seed stitch rows to the preferred head size
- Stitch counts per row are in <brackets>

- Blocking: To block, use a water and white vinegar solution to help keep your colors bright and minimize any bleeding.



Abbreviations:

CO: Cast On	M: Make
ST/S:	K2tog: Knit two together
Stitch/es	BO: Bind Off
K: Knit	P: Purl

The Pattern:

CO: 3

- **Row 1:** k across <3>
- **Row 2:** k, M2, k to end <5> Row 3: k across <5>
- **Row 4:** K3, M2, k to end <7> Row 5: K across <7>
- **Row 6:** K4, M2, k to end <9> Row 7: K across <9>
- **Row 8:** K5, M2, k to end <11> Row 9: K across <11>
- **Row 10:** K6, M1, k to end <12> Row 11: *k1, p1* <12>
- **Row 12:** *p1, k1* <12>

Repeat rows 11 and 12 for 17 inches, 79 rows

- **Row 91:** K, k2tog, k to end <11>

Repeat row 91 until you have 6 sts remaining

- **Row 97 (one row button hole):** k2, BO2, K2 <4>

- **Row 98:** K2, CO 2, k2 <6>
- **Row 99:** K across <6>
- **Row 100:** k2tog, k2, k2tog <4>
- **Row 101:** BO

Finishing Touches:

Secure button to opposite end of headband. Weave in loose ends with your tapestry needle. Button the headband and you're good to go!

La Vie En Rose Headband

Crochet Pattern

SKILL: BEGINNER

Materials Needed:

- 1 50g skein of DK Weight Herbal Dyed Recycled Silk Yarn
- 4.5 mm Crochet Hook
- Tapestry needle and scissors

Pattern Notes:

- Gauge: 3 stitches x 3 rows = 3 x 3 inches
- Finished Dimensions: Approximately 3 inches wide by 17 inches long (before edges are sewn together)
- Stitch counts per row are in <brackets>
- Blocking: To block, use a water and white vinegar solution to help keep your colors bright and minimize any bleeding



The Pattern:

CH 11

- **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd chain from your hook. Sc into every stitch, all the way to the end. Ch 3, turn work
- **Row 2:** 1 dc in 3rd st from hook. *Skip 2 sts, 3 dc in the next st *. Repeat from the * to * until 3 sts remain. Skip 2 sts, 2 dc into the last st. Ch 3, turn work
- **Row 3:** *3 dc into the space between dc clusters* Repeat from the * to * all the way to the end. 1 dc in the top of “Ch 3” from previous row. Ch 3, turn work
- **Row 4:** 1 dc in the same st *3 dc in the next space between dc clusters. Repeat from the * all the way to the end. 2 dc in the top of “ch 3” from previous row. CH 3, turn work

Repeat row 3 – 4 until you reach your desired length.

Abbreviations:

DC = Double Crochet

ST(S) = Stitch(es)

Ch = Chain

SC = Single Crochet

Finishing Touches:

Cast off leaving long tail. Whip stitch the ends together. Weave in loose threads.
