# Tropical Paradisee Shawlette Crochet Pattern 

SKILL: EASY by Janica Carter

## Materials Needed:

- 1 cake of Silk Blend Sport Weight 80-20 Rule Yarn
- US G/6 US (4 mm) crochet hook
- Tapestry needle and scissors


## Abbreviations:

| CH: Chain | DC: Double Crochet |
| :--- | :--- |
| ST/S: Stitch/es | SK: Skip |
| TR: Triple Crochet | CH-SP: Chain Space |
| BEG: Beginning | SC: Single Crochet |

## Pattern Notes:

- Finished Dimensions: Approximately 30 " W x $11^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{L}$
- Gauge: 2 shell sts and 8 rows in a shell pattern $=4$ " (not
 critical)
- Special Shell Stitch: ([1 tr, ch 1] 4 times, 1 tr) in st indicated


## The Pattern:

- Row 1: Using magic loop, ch 5, ([1 tr, ch 1] 3 times, 1 tr) in magic loop. Alternatively, ch 6, ([1 tr, ch 1] 3 times, 1 tr) in 2nd ch from hook.
- Row 2: Ch 5, turn; 1 shell in first tr, sk next tr, 1 sc in next tr, (1 shell, ch 1,1 tr) in 4 th ch of beg ch 5: 2 shells
- Row 3: Ch 5, turn; 1 shell in first tr, sk next 2 tr, 1 sc in next tr, 1 shell in next sc, sk next 2 tr, 1 sc in next tr, (1 shell, ch 1, 1 tr ) in 4th ch of turning ch: 3 shells.
- Row 4: Ch 5, turn; 1 shell in first tr, *sk next 2 tr, 1 sc in next tr, 1 shell in next sc; rep from *, ending with last shell in 4 th ch of turning ch, ch 1,1 tr in 4 th ch of turning ch: 4 shells.
- Rows 5-11: Rep Row 4, 7 times: 11 shells.
- Row 12: Ch 5, turn; 1 sc in next tr, (ch 5, 1 sc in next tr) across to last tr, ch 3, dc in 4th ch of turning ch.
- Row 13: Ch 5 , turn; sk 1st ch-3 sp, 1 sc in next ch-5 sp, (ch 5,1 sc in next ch-5 sp) across to last 2 ch- 5 sps, ch 3, dc in last ch-5 sp.
- Rows 14-17: Rep row 13, 4 times.

Break off yarn. Using yarn needle, weave in all yarn ends.

## Blocking

Soak shawlette in room temperature water no more than 20 minutes. Roll in towel to remove excess water. Pin shawlette into shape, stretching firmly, on flat surface and let dry at least 8 hours.
