'Paint by numbers' but with pixel stickers! This group analog activity instantly engages ALL ages and abilities. The image starts as a mystery - just a blank canvas and builds as everyone 'sticks together.' No one is left out.

Each kit has everything needed to complete the image:
a folded, coded poster
a color key*
more than enough stickers
*Many of our kits use our original 17 color key. The rest use 'custom colors' where the color key is printed on the sticker sheets.


1. Hide the cover!
2. Unfold the poster. Place it on a table, the floor, or tape it to a wall.
3. Place the color key nearby.
4. Grab some stickers. Check the color key... (for example, A = Black, $\mathrm{D}=$ Orange...), find the square coded for that color, and...

## FAQs

What if someone adds a sticker in the wrong place? No problem. The image will look fine if a few stickers are misplaced.

What if the stickers are not perfectly straight? That's perfectly OK. This is meant to be a casual, relaxing activity. Stickers do not have to be placed perfectly.

Are there Sticker Posters that are smaller / with fewer stickers? No, they are already very low-resolution images. Any lower (fewer pixels) and the image would not be recognizable.

What is the best age for a Sticker Poster? 5-105, and we mean it! Students who are just learning their letters enjoy it! Students with special needs love it! Teens can't get enough of it! Our Sticker Posters are popular in colleges/universities, office break rooms and senior facilities. It's also a great way to bring different ages/grades together.

How long does it take to complete a Sticker Poster? That depends. A group of enthusiastic 'stickerers' can complete an image in 1-2 hours, but if you hand out a few stickers at a time as a reward, it can take all year.
