

Make it Personal with a Welcome Message



The final page of this worksheet contains the same number of squares as a Standard StickTogether poster. Use the alphabet provided to create the letters of your message. Place the letters so they fit on the image.


On the poster, find the x/y coordinates of the top left pixel of the first letter of your message. With a light pencil, mark the squares that will require a pixel for your message.

Make sure to check the color key as you 'stickerize' your message. If you encounter a 'P' (white sticker) use a temporary light colored sticker (mark it with a dot so you know to remove it once the message is read).
