



# Vinyl Care Guide

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## To clean and maintain:

Whilst vinyls are designed to be easily cleaned, they are not self cleaning and require a regular maintenance regime to extend the life of the fit-out. Most spills and stains can easily be cleaned with a towel. Just wipe up the spills with a clean cloth.

Always test in an inconspicuous area first. In some instances not all stains can be completely removed.

We recommend using a specialist reputable and professional fabric or leather cleaning company at least once every two years to keep your furniture looking good and to increase the life of your furniture by up to 30%

- 02 Suitable for Leather, PVC, PU and Silicone smooth upholsteries.
- 03 Always pre-test on an inconspicuous area.
- 04 Ready to use, biodegradable and Eco-Safe.
