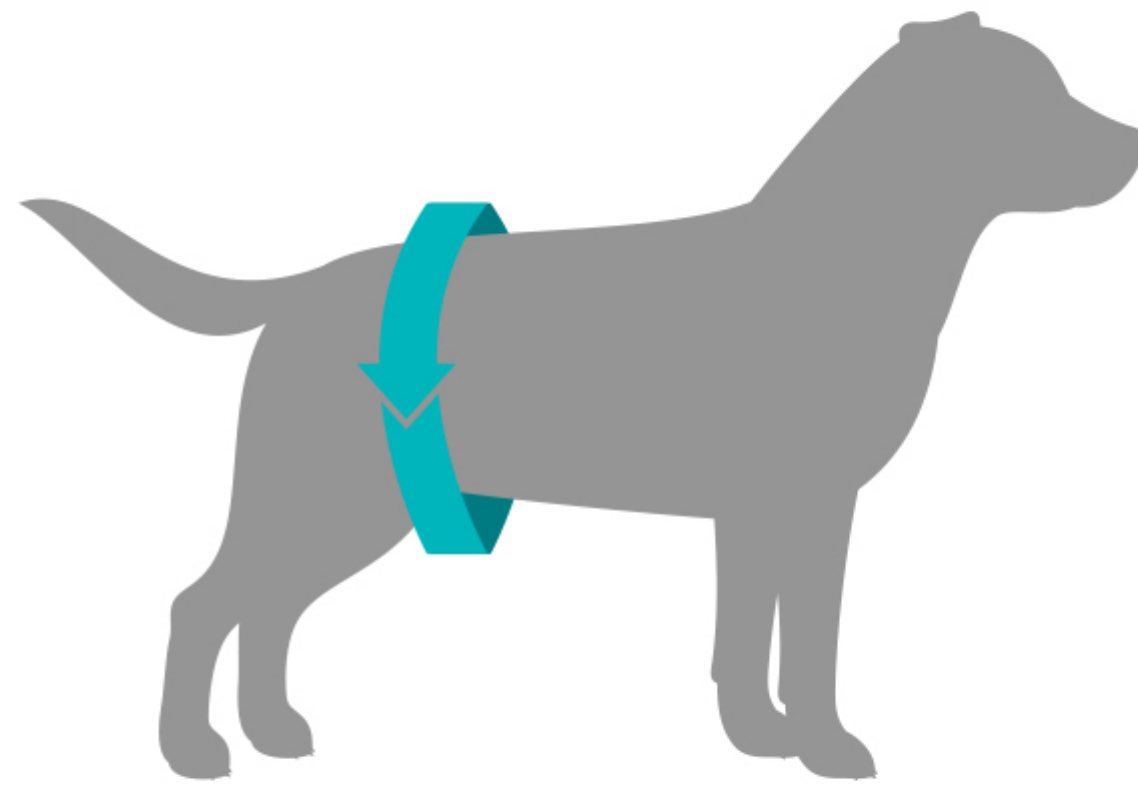

Pet Parents® Washable Belly Bands let your customer's handsome boy leave his mark without leaving a mess. The simple, efficient design saves him from leaving his scent in your customers' home, in just four easy steps!



Step

Wrap the belly band around the dog's underbelly, like the diagram below shows.

WAIST (20-25")



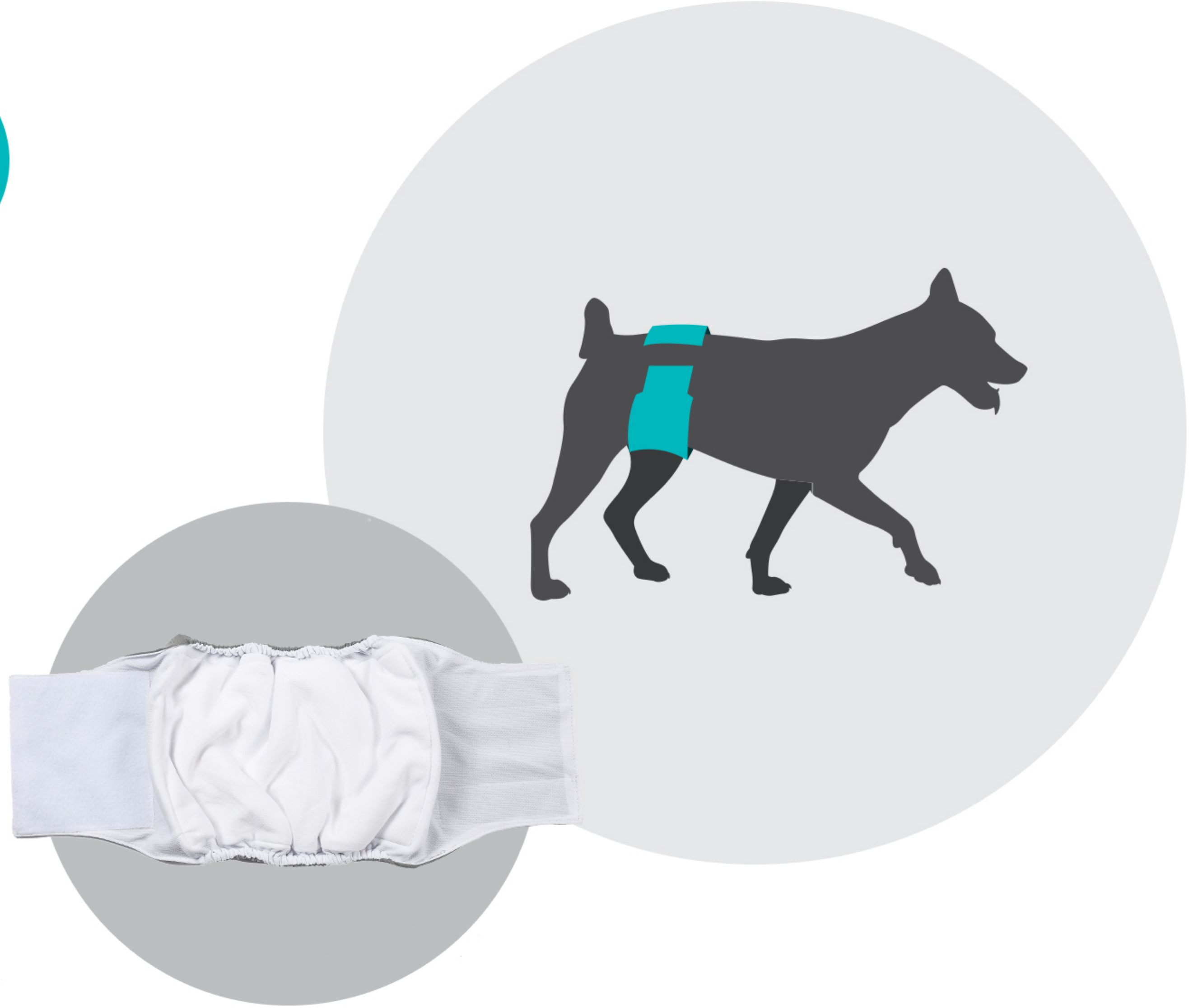
WAIST (25-34")

Do not let your customer guess his or her dog's size. Have them properly measure their dog's waist and then choose the size that their waist measurements fall under in our sizing chart. If they fall between sizes, take into consideration their weight/body type to choose the best size (i.e. a heavier weight/frame, go up a size, and a smaller weight/frame, go down a size).

You can also have your customers try on a belly band since our packages are resealable. This will reduce returns and make sure your customers go home with the right size the first time!

Step **#2**

Place the belly band under the dog, so the white padding/fabric is facing upward and over his male parts, like the photo and diagram to the right displays.

#3

Secure Velcro closure on top and adjust for proper fit.



Step **#4**

Stay clean and dry!

Yep, it's as simple as that! Your customer simply wraps the belly band around their dog's belly, making sure his private area is covered well, and any future mess is prevented!

Your customer can gauge whether or not the belly band is adjusted and fitting correctly by making sure their dog is moving around easily, because if he is having difficulties moving that usually means he is uncomfortable and the band is too tight. However, keep in mind that some dogs may freeze up when the belly band is placed on them because they are unsure what to think. Remind your customers that this can happen, and that doesn't mean that the band is too tight, their fur-baby just needs to be praised and encouraged so he can get used to it.

In addition to that, if the band is moving around into different places, that it is a sign that it is too loose and can be adjusted to be tighter while still providing comfort.



Additional tip

Remind your customers to change their fur-baby's belly band at least every 3 to 4 hours. It's best if your customer replaces one as soon as it is soiled. Allowing urine to sit against their dog's skin for a long period of time can cause infections and will make the dog uncomfortable. No one wants that!
