








WALL PLUG

ELECTRIC CONNECTIONS

ALL WIRING SHOULD BE DONE BY A QUALIFIED LICENCED ELECTRICIAN



WARNING: Shut off power before wiring the mirror.







MIRROR FEATURES


- 5mm copper free silver mirror
- High output LED lighting: CRI 90+, 3000-6500K CCT, IP44
- Colour changing and dimmable touch switch for surface LED
- Defogger

Electric wiring: Be sure to provide enough wire to make the proper and safe connection to the Field/Power.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1 PLACEMENT


Select the desired position of the mirro Mark the curve at the top of the mirro



2 SUPPORT LOCATION

Measure the center of the holes and mark the drilling locations ensure marking are leveled.




3 INSTALL SCREWS

Using a drill, make holes and fill with supplied plugs and screws. Leave a gap of 2 - 3mm between the head of the screw and the wall.

PLACEMENT
Place the mirror against the wall and slide down as shown in images.



FINAL ASSEMBLY

How to use Defogger Switch and Dimmer Switch:
Touch to turn the task light and defogger on or off.
Press and hold to change the colour temprature of task light.
Use and Maintenance:
CAUTION:
Mirror and mirror's body are constructed of mirrored glass and aluminum. Use a damp cloth to clean your mirrors. Do not use any abrasive material as it may damage the surface and finish of the mirror. A mild detergent may be used to clean the surfaces of the mirror. When cleaning spray the cloth, not the mirrors or surrounding surfaces.
