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Mary's Fingerless Gloves

MATERIALS

1 skein of Frolicking Feet Superwash Merino yarn
3.5 mm crochet hook
Optional knitted cuff with 3 mm double point needles

CROCHET TERMS

sc single crochet
dc double crochet
hdc half double crochet
ch chain
sp space
S shell – (dc, ch 1, dc)
D shell – (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc)

KNITTING TERMS (if you choose the knitted cuff option below)

Co cast-on
K knit
P purl

Gauge 2 pattern repeats (D shell, S shell, D shell, S shell) = 3"
Because of the stretchy nature of the lace it is not necessary to get exact gauge. Keep trying on the glove for fit. If it is too loose, go down a hook size.

OPTIONS FOR CUFFS

Knitted cuff option:

Loosely cast on 40 stitches and join into round. Place marker to denote beg of rnd and work in k2, p2 ribbing for 1.5" or to your personal taste. Try on for fit. Cast off in pattern loosely and slip st to next knit stitch. Do not fasten off.

Crocheted cuff option:

- Row A: Chain 12 and hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch across, ch 2 and turn. (10 hdc)
- Row B: Hdc in back loop across row; ch 2, turn. (10 hdc) Repeat Row B 12 times or until it fits your wrist. To join cuff, ch 1, turn, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each of the 10 stitches across. Do not fasten off.

BODY OF GLOVE (both versions)

- Round 1: Evenly space shells around the cuff: Ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 2 dc, work S shell, * work D shell, work S shell* around. Join with slip st to top of ch 3. (10 shells total)
- Round 2: Sl stitch over to next ch 1 sp, ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 2 dc, S shell in next ch 1 sp, * D shell in next ch 1 sp, S shell in next ch 1 sp*, repeat around. Join with slip st to top of ch 3.
- Rounds 3-6: Repeat Round 2. (Try it on, you can shorten or lengthen at this point)
- Round 7: Sl stitch over to next ch 1 sp, ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 2 dc, ch 8, skip one shell * D shell in next ch 1 sp, S shell in next ch 1 sp*, repeat around. Join with slip st to top of ch 3.
- Round 8: Sl stitch over to next ch 1 sp, ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 2 dcs, skip 2 chs, S shell in next ch, skip 2 chs, S shell in next ch, skip 2 chs, * D shell in next ch 1 sp, S shell in next ch 1 space*, repeat around. Join with slip st to top of ch 3. (12 shells).
- Round 9: Sl stitch over to next ch 1 sp, ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 2 dcs, S shell in next 2 ch 1 sps, * D shell in next ch 1 sp, S shell in next ch 1 sp* repeat around. Join with slip st to top of ch 3. (12 shells) Try on, repeat till you reach length you wish. (I did 4 rounds.)
- Last Round: Sl stitch over to next ch 1 sp, ch 4, 1 dc, * S shell in next ch 1 sp* repeat around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4 (12 shells). Try on, repeat till you reach length you wish. I did 4 rounds. Fasten off.

THUMB OPENING

- Round 1: Attach yarn in ch 1 space of S shell. Ch 4, 1 dc, work 5 S shells evenly around the opening. Sl st to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4 to end round . (6 shells)
- Round 2: Sl st in next ch1 sp, ch 4, 1 dc, work S shells in ch1 sps around, sl st to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4. Repeat for 3 rounds or until you reach the length you wish. Fasten off.

Weave in all ends.
