



G IS FOR GEORGE

Australian Wild Ale • 6.5% ABV • 500ml

Bottle Release: February 2019

STORY

One of a two part Australian Wild Ale series, G is for George is named after my grandfather, George Kingsley Sutton, amateur archaeologist, gastronomist, patron to the arts. (You may remember the beers Yvonne and Gaston, named after my Dad's Mum and her brother (my great uncle), from a while back?) Recently, I was reflecting on my Mum's parents and thought it befitting to name each of these two new wild ales after Kinglsey; an adventurous spirit and an inspiration.

The beer itself: a pale malt base beer, barrel fermented and aged for 12 months with a further 2 months on fresh Victorian raspberries—100kg per 1000L.

TASTING NOTES

Nothing quite beats fresh, hand-picked raspberries. The two months on raspberries has resulted in not only vibrant colour but also bright fruit character that is complemented by the acid and malt profile of the beer.

FOOD PAIRING

Would match superbly with pavlova and summer berries.

CELLARING POTENTIAL

Will reward careful cellaring – store upright in a cool, dark place. Ageing potential of at least 5 years. Will continue to develop in bottle though bright fruit characters will drop off over time.
