STORY

A gueuze is not only a test of patience, but also a test of the brewer's blending ability. Time Lord is a nod to the age of the barrels, 3 years old, 2 years old and 1 year old, and the time taken to have to create a beer like this. Plus, Matt is a Dr. Who tragic...

TASTING NOTES

This beer is a little bit of an enigma. Intense funk and sourness, yet balanced beautifully. The acid profile connects so well with the natural carbonation, making this beer a delight to drink.

FOOD PAIRING

Pottekees (a traditional Belgian dish mixing fresh cheese, and Brussels cheese (we use Meredith dairy goats feta), chopped spring onions, black pepper, and a generous splash of Time Lord) spread liberally on fresh artisan bread.

CELLARING POTENTIAL

Will reward careful cellaring – store upright in a cool, dark place. Ageing potential of at least 5 years. Will continue to develop in bottle.
