

Plug unit into properly grounded power outlet

Power unit on by pressing the top ON/OFF button




POWER - Press ON/OFF button once.

To change the temperature setting, press the HEAT button.



To change the air pressure setting, press the AIR button.



Begin to dry the hair by rotating the dryer over the head, keeping the dryer a safe distance from scalp to avoid excessive heat exposure or discomfort.

When style is complete, power off the appliance by pressing the ON/OFF button.

To ensure proper storage, allow appliance to cool down prior to storing.



If dryer should overheat, all eight LED button will simultaneously flash. To reset, follow directions below:

Step1. Unplug dryer

Step2. Clean dust filter

Step3. Wait 2-3mimutes before turning dryer back on.

WHEN USING NOZZLES OR ANY DRYER ATTACHMENTS, ENSURE THAT THE AIR FLOW IS NOT OBSTRUCTED/BLOCKED.
OBSTRUCTION OF AIRFLOW CAN RESULT IN INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL DAMAGE TO YOUR DRYER, SUCH AS MELTING.


OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

This hair dryer is equipped with an Appliance Leakage Circuit Interrupter (ALCI) built into the plug. This safety feature will make the appliance inoperable under under some abnormal conditions, such as immersion in water. The ALCI safety device is equipped with a test feature so that its operation can be checked.

NOTE: Check the ALCI safety feature every time you use your hair dryer.

To ensure the ALCI safety device is functioning properly, perform the following test:

- 1. Press the RESET button located on the ALCI plug.
 This will ensure the hair dryer is in the operable position.
- 2. Plug the hair dryer into the electrical outlet.
- Press the Test button located on the plug. If the ALCI is functioning properly, the RESET button will pop out and the hair dryer will be inoperable.
- 4. Press the RESET button to reactivate the ALCI safety device and to use your hair dryer.
- 5. Do not use the unit if the RESÉT button does not pop out. Return it immediately for service.



At any time, when this hair dryer encounters an electrical shock hazard, it will immediately shut off. To restore power, the RESET button on the ALCI safety device must be pressed to reactivate the circuit.

IF THIS APPLIANCE IS IMMERSED IN WATER, DO NOT ATTEMPT TO RESET THE ALCI SAFETY DEVICE. PLEASE TAKE THE UNIT TO THE NEAREST SERVICE FACILITY FOR EXAMINATION.

WARNING TO REDUCE THE RISK OF BURNS, ELECTROCUTION, FIRE, OR INJURY TO PERSONS: ■ Always unplug it immediately after using. ■ Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a bath tub or sink. ■ Do not use it while bathing. Never block the air openings of the appliance or place it on soft surface, such as a bed or couch, where the air openings may be blocked. ■ Insert the plug to the AC outlet fully for normal operation, failure to insert plug fully may result in overheating and fire ■ Never use while sleeping. ■ Never drop or insert any objects into any opening or hose.

Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered. ■ Do not use an extension cord with this appliance. ■ Air outlet grill and attachments may be very hot during use. Allow them to cool before handling, Do not place the appliance directly on any surface while operating. ■ While using the appliance, keep your hair out of it. Keep your hair away from the air inlets. ■ To prolong the life of the dryer, keep filters clean of hair and dust.

Do not use with voltage converter.

Do not direct hot air toward eyes or other heat sensitive areas. For an appliance required to have a polarized plug, the following instructions shall be provided: "This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it sill does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature." ■ The appliance is not to be used by persons (including children aged from 8 years) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. ■ Children being supervised not to play with the appliance ■ Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision ■ When the hairdryer is used in a bathroom, unplug it after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard even when the hairdryer is switched off. ■ When using nozzles or any dryer attachments, ensure that the air flow is not obstructed/blocked. Obstruction of airflow can result in internal and external damage to your dryer, such as melting.

PRECAUTION ■ Strictly observe all of the instructions: WARNING, PRECAUTION when using the appliance. ■ Never allow the power supply cord to be pulled, twisted, or severely bent. Never wrap the cord tightly around the dryer. ■ Do not place any heavy object on the cord. ■ Do not damage the electrical cord. It may result in electrical shock, short-circuit, or fire ■ Inspect the cord frequently for damage. Stop using the dryer immediately if damage is visible or unit stops or operates intermittently. ■ Do not wash the dryer with water. ■ Do not open the dryer or attempt to fix it when malfunctioning. ■ Do not disassemble the dryer for any purpose. ■ Unplug the appliance by pulling the plug not the cord. ■ Do not alter or modify the cord in any way. ■ When not in use, your dryer should be disconnected, allowed to cool, and stored in a safe, dry location, out of reach of children.
