## HAPPY CAT LEARNING CLOCK

Learn to tell time, to count, and to recognize colors, shapes, and the numbers 1 through 12. Recomended for age 18 months+

MATERIALS: GLUE STICK, COLORING UTENSILS, SCISSORS, SMALL LENGTH OF STRING, YARN OR RIBBON.

- 1. Color in the cheerful cat face.
- 2. Glue the sheet onto card and leave to dry.
- 3. Once dry, cut around the clock face, clock hands, and number shapes.
- 4. Using the end of the scissors, carefully pierce the clock and clock hands (where indicated with a cross) to make a small hole.
- 5. Thread the length of string, yarn or ribbon through each pierced hole, starting with the clock, followed by the large clock hand and the small hand.
- 6. Make a knot at each end close to the clock, ensuring the clock hands move freely.
- 7. Cut off any excess string, yarn or ribbon to complete your learning clock.

Have fun matching up the shapes and colors and rotate the clock hands to explore the beginning stages of telling the time!
