

ice dye PILLOWGASE KIT

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS

2 SCREEN PRINTED PILLOWCASES 16" X 16"
(STUFFING NOT INCLUDED)
1 ICE DYE TRAY

4 TIE DYE PACKS
2 Packets Cute as Coral Dye
8 2 Packets Lit as Lilac Dye
1 PAIR OF GLOVES

SAFETY & PRECAUTIONS

Be sure to use proper precautions when using this product to avoid potential skin reaction. Use the provided gloves and protect face to avoid eye and respiratory irritation.

- Avoid breathing dust
- Wash hands and face thoroughly after handling
- In case of inadequate ventilation, wear respiratory protection
- Wear protective gloves, eye protection and face protection

CLEANING TIPS

Cover your entire working area with a plastic tablecloth, garbage bags, or newspaper.

With proper setup, cleaning up a non-absorbent work surface should be easy with just soap and water.

LET'S GET STARTED!




Grab a pillowcase and turn it inside out. Get it completely wet and wring it out leaving it damp.



Bunch the pillowcase up and place it on the provided tray.




Add up to 32oz of ice. We used 2 full 16oz cups. Any more than that and the melted ice will fill above the tray insert.



ADD DYE

Rip or cut the corners off of 1 dye packet of each color. Sprinkle the dye over the ice. You can use all of it or only some of it. Cover the ice in tie dye powder or leave some areas white, it's up to you!



Set the tray aside for 12 hours or more. The longer it sits, the more saturated the colors will be. As the ice melts, the water mixes with the dye and creates cool and unique patterns.



Once set, rinse your pillowcase out with cold water until the water runs clear. After it is rinsed, wash in a washing machine for a full normal cycle with like colors.



DO IT AGAIN

Now that you have the hang of it, do it again! Before starting with your second pillowcase, rinse off your tray until the water runs clear.



FINAL STEP

Add some fill or pillow inserts, zip them shut, then get cozy with your creations!
