# BATH BOMB KIT

MAKE 3 GUMMY BEAR BATH BOMBS

## DESIGN GUIDE

### Introduction

Grab your favorite lab coat (a.k.a. bathrobe) and get ready for some squeaky clean fun. Create 3 gummy bear shaped bath bombs, then drop them into your tub to watch a cool and colorful chemical reaction – from bears to bubbles!

### Getting Started

Gather mixing bowls and paper towel from your home. Find a nice open working space and get ready to have some fun! Once made, bath bombs can be used immediately or stored in a dry place for up to 6 months.

### Materials

- 3 Packets Powder A: Soda Ash
- 3 Packets Powder B: Citric Acid Mixture
- Glycerine Colorants: Pink, Green, Blue
- Strawberry Scent
- 3 Gummy Bear Molds

### What You'll Need From Home:

- Mixing Bowl
- Paper Towel
- Mask Optional:  
Citric Acid can get dusty when mixing

## MIX IT!

1



In a medium-sized mixing bowl add one packet of Powder B and an entire bottle of colorant.

2



Use your hands to thoroughly mix powder B and the whole bottle of colorant together completely. Color beads will form, rub between your fingertips to fully mix together. The consistency should start to resemble slightly damp sand.

**TIP:** Dye won't permanently dye your fingers so no need to wear gloves.

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## MIX IT CONTINUED!

3



Mix in 4-6 drops of strawberry scent.

4



Add **Powder A** and mix thoroughly with hands and fingertips again.

5



Pack mixture tightly into a mold until it's filled to the top.

**Note:** There will be extra mixture. Save it in a bag to sprinkle in the tub at bathtime or use the leftover mixture from all three bears to make a fun multicolored bear.

Let your bath bomb mixture sit in the mold for at least 20 minutes!

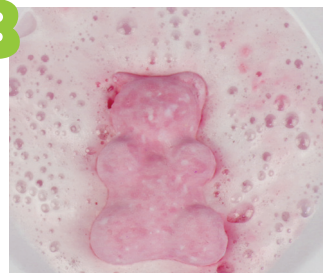

Gently flip out of the mold and tap to release the bear. Pulling gently on the sides can help the bear come out smoothly.

Make all 3 bears at the same time or save some fun for later.

Place your finished bear into the bath and watch the water trigger a reaction between the citric acid and soda ash base - making carbon dioxide bubbles – and lots of fizzy fun!

## LAYERING COLORS

1



Start with two or three bowls and make different colors of bath bombs by following instructions 1-4 above.

Place a big scoop of one color in top portion of mold. Next, scoop a different color and press down.

2



Complete steps 6-8 from above and enjoy a multicolored gummy bear bath bomb!

## IMPORTANT INFO

Bath bombs and their ingredients should not be ingested or misused. Adult supervision is recommended.



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
