

Cookies

We use cookies for certain areas of our website at www.gographene.com (the "Site"). Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive by a website. Among other things, cookies help us improve our Site and your experience.

The cookies used on our Site are "performance" cookies, as categorised under the International Chamber of Commerce United Kingdom Cookie Guide.

"Performance" cookies collect information about how users navigate this Site, for example, which pages users access most frequently. They identify how users interact with our Site, any errors that occur, which pages are not used often, which pages take a long time to load, which pages users tend to visit and in what order. These cookies do not collect any information which could identify you and are only used to help us improve how our Site works and understand what interests our Site's users.

Cookie Settings

We will ask for your consent to the use of the cookies set out in this Cookies Policy when you first access our Site and if we introduce any new cookies to the Site. When you first visit the Site, a box will appear asking you to agree to the cookies that we set on the Site. If you agree to cookies from our Site by clicking on the "I agree" button, we will set cookies on your device. If you wish to delete the cookies we have set on your device, please refer to your browser Help menu.

If you do not agree to cookies from our Site, please click on the "No thanks" button. You will still be able to access our Site although certain features or services on our Site may be affected, for example, certain features may not function and you may not be able to access certain areas.

You can usually choose to set your browser to warn you when a cookie is being sent or to remove or reject cookies. Each browser is a little different, so look at your browser Help menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookie settings. If you choose to remove or reject cookies, it may affect many features or services on our Site, for example certain features may not function and you may not be able to access certain areas.
