RELEASE INSTRUCTIONS

Diglyphus isea Leafminer Exterminator

- Once Leafminer-feeding marks are present releases should be planned.
- It is best to release the Diglyphus when the first leafminer larvae are found.
- Approximately 1 Diglyphus should be released per 10 sq. ft., weekly for several weeks since the Leafminer pest has a short period of vulnerability to the Diglyphus wasp.
- Introduce Diglyphus as soon as possible after receipt.
- Best if introduced in the evening.
- Simply open the container – walk through the area and allow the wasps to fly out of the container.

Strategic Considerations: Many pesticides will have a negative effect on the development of Diglyphus. Avoid the use of systemic insecticides or pesticides with long residual action.
