



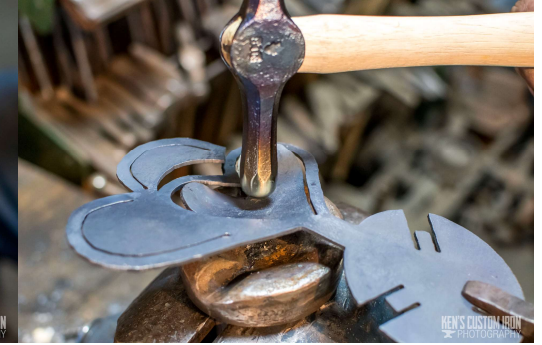
# Heart Candle Holder Project ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



1. Map out a few lines and begin by using a stamp set to stamp your sweetheart's name onto the heart.



2. Use a small ball peen hammer, chisel, eye punch, or fullering tool to add texture to the hearts as desired.

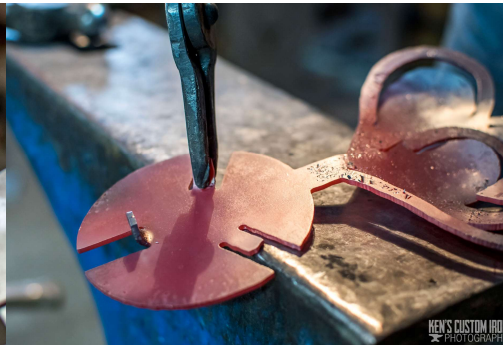


3. Use a dishing hammer and cupping tool to add depth and dimension to the hearts. \*SEE NOTE\*

**NOTE:** If you do not have a dishing/embossing hammer or a cupping tool, you can use a small ball peen hammer and a block of wood.



4. Adding dimension will help your project to be unique!



5. Lay your heart face-down and use a pair of scroll tongs to bend each of the tabs on the base plate up 90 degrees.



6. Use two pairs of tongs to bend the heart backward a little more than 90 degrees.



7. Make final adjustments as needed.



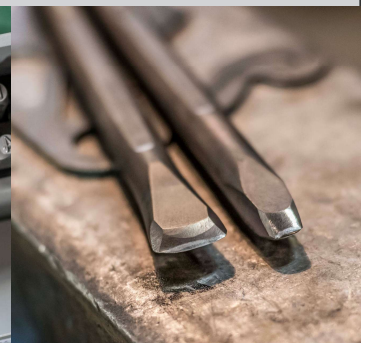
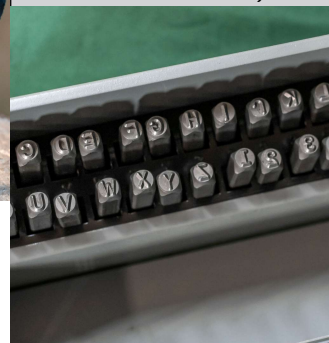
