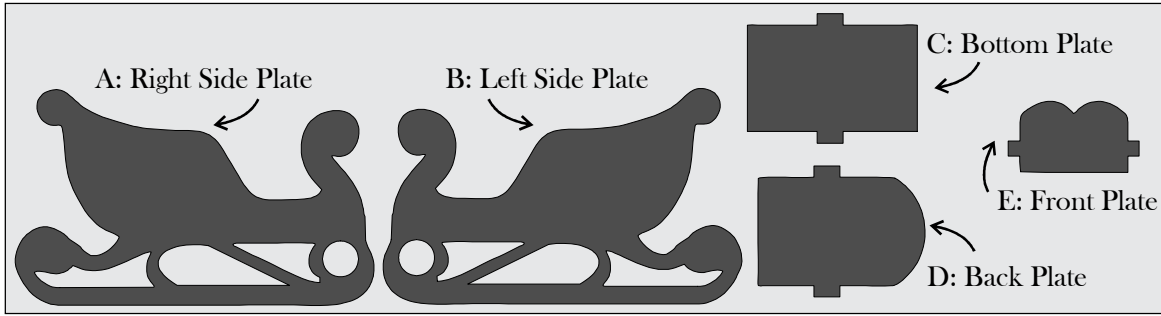




# Sleigh Project

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cut the thin chain-link marks to break the pieces apart using a saw, zip wheel, or chisel. Be careful not to cut the mounting tabs from the Front, Back, and Bottom plates!

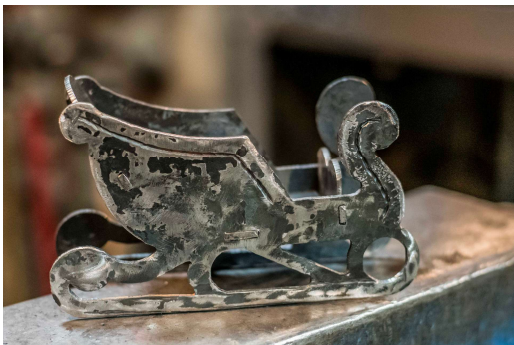
2. Use a file, belt sander, or flap disc to clean up your cuts. Be careful, once again, not to cut your mounting tabs!

3. Be creative and make your sleigh unique. Draw some simple lines on your sleigh and...



4. Use a small chisel or other various hammers and tools to add detail and texturing. Repeat this to the opposite side of the other side plate.

5. Place the textured side of the Left Side Plate face down. Insert the tabs of the Front, Back, and Bottom Plates into the Left Side Plate and gently place the Right Side Plate on top (making sure that the Bottom Plate isn't backwards). Lightly peen the tabs over. Once everything is in place, use harder blows to finish peening out the tabs on both sides. (Alternatively, you could weld the tabs!)



6. Apply finishing touches. Leave as is, paint it, stamp a name/date into it, or decorate as desired.
