## MISSING LINK

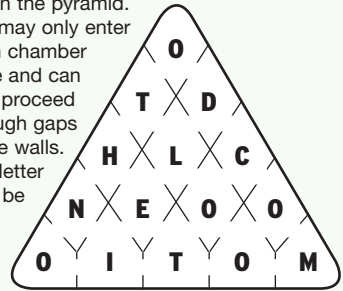
