Guidelines

✓ Good; 34 Excellent.

Any word found in the Concise Oxford Dictionary (Tenth Edition) is eligible with the following exceptions: proper nouns; plurals; nouns, pronouns and adjectives in the possessive, third person singular forms; hyphenated words; contractions and abbreviations; vulgar slang; words in variant spellings of the same word (where another variant is also given).
