


First of all, what are PFAS and why should I care?

PFAS (Perfluoroalkyl And Polyfluoroalkyl Substances) are a category of man-made contaminants that are commonly used in firefighting foam, Teflon, non-stick surfaces, stain-resistant surfaces, and food packaging. Some health agencies believe that there are over 4,000 different variations present in the environment.

CDC has linked exposure to PFAS with an increased risk of cancer, increased cholesterol levels, a weakened immune system, and hormonal disruptions. Even small amounts of PFAS are extremely toxic.
