To Get Started:

A) Turn the Master On/Off Switch On

- B) A Warning Message will appear for you to check the press and surroundings to ensure safety, and then Press the *Safety Reset* on the left menu bar. Now you have access to the entire suite of Press Functions & Options.
- C) All of the Items on the Left Navigation Column are all "1-Touch" direct access Functions.

 All of the Items on the Bottom are "Menu Access" functions, where options are selected and set depending on your job requirements.
- D) Proceed and Press any of the Menu Items to set the job parameters you need. For example, Press *Heads* to turn individual print heads on, set print and flood speeds, set number of strokes, etc. Press *Flash* to establish where the Flash Unit(s) is located around the circle and Turn On as needed.
