HUMAN KINETICS VIRTUAL HEALTH AND PE CONFERENCE

- Required weekly synchronous ZOOM sessions
- Allowed them to talk to their peers during ZOOM sessions
- Assigned sharing of what is working
- Set up breakout rooms to discuss their choice of what is **not** working
- Shared videos they created
- Collaborated to get creative with equipment and space
- Suggested assigning homework, journaling, extra credit for engaging
- Encouraged them to be realistic and not be too hard on themselves
