Job Purpose Summary:

The Cold Brew Production Associate will be responsible for production and delivery of JVG's cold brew products for our retail cafes and wholesale customers. They will be expected to fill orders, clean and maintain brewing equipment, and deliver orders according to a prearranged schedule.

Reports To: Beverage and Product Development Manager

Status: Part Time Hourly Temp (3 months), Maximum 12 Hours/Week

1. Fill cold brew orders of kegs, concentrate carboys, and bottles for Joe Van Gogh retail cafes and wholesale customers.
 - Steep, drain, and filter coffee.
 - Fill receptacles for delivery (kegs, carboys, and bottles).
 - Pressurize kegs.
 - With Beverage and Product Development Manager, create a system and schedule of production and cleaning to ensure optimal efficiency and product quality.
 - Check every batch for quality.
 - Ensure cold chain throughout production and delivery.
2. Cleaning and Facility Maintenance
 - Implement a system that rigorously ensures that all brewing equipment and coffee receptacles are cleaned and sanitized after every use- this includes: large brewers, bottling buckets, drain lines, filtration media, kegs, carboys, bottles – anything that touches product to be consumed.
 - Maintaining a clean work space during and after use at cold brew production and storage facility (commissary).
 - Maintain a positive relationship and responsiveness to the concerns of commissary management.
3. Deliver Cold Brew
 - Delivers cold brew to retail cafes and wholesale customers.
 - Answers questions customers and retail managers may have promptly and professionally.
 - Alerts Beverage and Product Development Manager if there are any concerns along the supply chain that need to be addressed.
4. Professional Development
 - Seek self-guided opportunities to learn about: coffee, sensory analysis, and large scale food production.
 - Make suggestions to improve product and day to day operations.
