


What To Ask Your Doctor Checklist

9 MONTH CHECKUP - CHECKLIST 1 YEAR CHECKUP - CHECKLIST

Crawling on all fours in a typical pattern (not with one leg up or scooting on the bum!)
Pulling to stand
Cruising along furniture
Pincer grasp development
Making / imitating sounds such as "mamama" and "dadada"
Recognizes name and the word "no"
Pointing to objects in the environment
Plays peekaboo
Transfers toys from one hand to another
Recognizes familiar faces
Tolerating a variety of sensory input: textures, sounds, visuals, etc. (No adverse reactions)

Primitive reflex check
Walking or showing signs of being ready to walk
Standing without help
Eating and engaging with a variety of foods and textures
Shows fear, becomes upset when main caregiver leaves
Assisting with dressing
Imitating words
Imitating gestures like waving
Engages in container play - taking items in / out
Pointing with index finger
Plays hide-and-seek type games - looking for objects that you hide
