



## **Saccades Visual Chart**

Use the top 4 images as the "key."


Starting on the first row (flower), use pointer finger to touch image while saying it, then match to the "key" - again touching image with pointer finger while saying it.




























































## pdqb Chart

Read the chart by saying the name of each lowercase letter. | Add arm movements for the curve of each letter - p and b are "right" while d and q and "left" | Additionally identify "top" or "bottom" for the curve of each letter - p and q are "top" while b and d are "bottom".

If the chart is too visually overwhelming, fold in half so fewer letters are visible.
