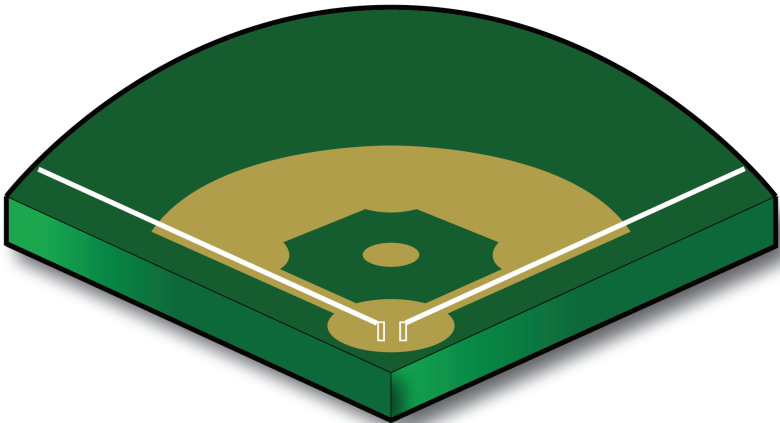




PORT-A-FIELD Baseball and Softball Foul Lines Instructions



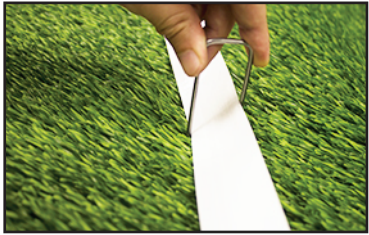
Step 1: Locate a starting point on your playing area for a corner of your field. Insert an anchor through the ring into the ground. Start at the outside of the batters box. Anchor ring into the ground and walk to the outfield, as you unreel your field the lines will be marked to show 45ft and 60ft.



Step 2: The sidelines are labeled to note whether you are starting with at home plate or in the outfield.



Step 3: When the foul line is complete attach the second anchor. When foul line number one is complete walk back to the batters box and repeat Steps One and Two. Make sure to pull the material tight when unreeling the field.



Step 4: Wickets are optional for the perimeter and should only be applied as needed. The field lines are designed to move upon contact, and easily go back into position.

Place a wicket at the lowest point of any dip or low spot on the field, then usually not more than every 30 ft or 10 steps around the perimeter.

To apply, straddle the perimeter line with a wicket and fully insert into the ground to snug the line to the playing surface.
