



a perfect fit

how to measure your space before you buy



Before purchasing your new M|W table, it is important to make sure the product you've chosen will fit in your space. Low ceilings, doorways, staircases, tight corners & elevators can all present challenges. Follow these guidelines to determine the best fit for your space.

start with your space

- * Measure the heights and widths of all doorways and hallways, including any exterior entrances.
- * Measure the distance from the entry door to the opposite wall to determine your entry clearance.
- * Consider potential obstacles such as drop ceilings, stairways, corners and hanging lights.
- * Use a template constructed from cardboard cut to the size of the table top and "walk" it through doorways, stairways, the elevator door & hallways.
- * If you must use an elevator, measure the elevator interior height, elevator opening and opposite wall distance.

measuring your new products

We provide the lengths and widths of all our available slabs. If you are purchasing a top and base, the final height of the piece will be 29.5 inches. Tables shipped within Washington will be blanket-wrapped and delivered assembled. Those shipped outside of Washington will be crated and delivered unassembled.

important considerations

Ensure a delivery truck can fit down your road and there is a place for the truck to park.

If you have loading dock hours, make sure you note this in your order so the truck is not turned away. (Additional delivery attempts will incur additional fees to the purchaser of the product.)

Crated products will be unloaded from the truck but not delivered inside so ensure you have the necessary assistance to bring your products inside your space.
