History

Prié blanc is a white <u>Italian wine grape</u> variety that is grown almost exclusively in the <u>Valle d'Aosta DOC</u> of northwest Italy. The Valle d'Aosta varietal wine Blanc de Morgex et de La Salle is made from Prié blanc grapes.

Through a complex pedigree it appears to have some genetic relationship with most every other grape variety in the region.

Ampelographers do not yet know definitively the origins of Prié blanc but evidence shows that it is a very old variety that has been growing in the Valle d'Aosta region of northwest Italy since at least 1691 when it was documented as one of the grapes growing in the commune of Saint-Pierre near the city of Aosta
