

Modberry's Audio/Video Interfaces

Video (HDMI)

Modberry is equipped with HDMI port that you can use to connect with any monitor that supports this interface.

When you do so, by default you will see the prompt.

X server

You may want to use GUI when Modberry is connected to monitor.

To start X server, just type:

```
startx
```

in prompt. You will be taken to default Desktop for your user.

Virtual Terminals

You may use terminal in GUI, but if you want to be taken back to one of the virtual terminals, use this key combination:

```
alt ctrl F[1-6]
```

By using ALT CTRL F1, you will be taken to tty1, using ALT CTRL F2 will take you to tty2 and so forth.

Audio

HDMI

By default audio output is going through HDMI as well, so if your monitor have speakers, the audio output will go through them.

Analog (jack) [OPTIONAL]

Modberry can also equipped with a simple jack port on request - just plug-in your speakers, headphones or whatever device you want to output sound, and you're set.
