## Size

Pram[Cot]: 55[70] cm, 21 ¾[27 ½] in by 65[90] cm, 25 ½[35 ½] in

## Materials

### Rico Design Baby Dream DK:

6[9] x 50 gm balls in Beige-Green[Purple-Fuchsia] shade 010[008]

1 pair 3.25mm (UK 10) single pointed knitting needles

1 pair 4mm (UK 8) single pointed knitting needles

Cable Needle (cn)

## Gauge or Tension

23 sts and 29 rows to a 10cm (4in) square in bobble pattern with 4mm needles.

## Abbreviations

**St/sts** – stitch/stitches

**K/P** – knit/purl

**Beg/Rep/patt(s)** – beginning/repeat/pattern(s)

**Cont/inc/foll** – continue/increase/following

**RS/WS** – right side/wrong side

**Kfb** – knit into the front and back of a stitch to create an extra stitch

**6 st-LPC** – slip 3 sts onto the cn and hold at the front, p3, then k3 from the cn

**C6F** – cable 6 front: slip 3 sts onto the cn and hold at the front, k3, then k3 from the cn

**6 st RPC** – slip 3 sts onto the cn and hold at the back, k3, then p3 from the cn

**MB** – make bobble: (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in 1 st, turn and p5, turn and pass the 4 sts just worked, one at a time, over the last st, knit this st through the back of the loop

**C6B** – cable 6 back: slip 3 sts onto the cn and hold at the back, k3, then k3 from the cn

## Pattern Stitches

### Stocking Stitch (st st)

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** Purl.

### Bobble Pattern

Worked over multiples of 8 + 4 sts and 12 rows.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2 and all even rows:** Purl.

**Row 3:** K2, \*k5, MB, k2: rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 5 and 7:** Knit.

**Row 9:** K2, \*k1, MB, k6: rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 11:** Knit.

**Row 12:** Purl.

## Cable Panel

**Worked over 38 sts and 10 rows.**

**Row 1 (RS):** P4, 6 st LPC, p6, C6F, p6, 6 st RPC, p4.

**Row 2:** K7, p3, k6, p6, k6, p3, k7.

**Row 3:** P7, 6 st LPC, C6B, C6F, 6 st RPC, p7.

**Row 4:** K10, p18, k10.

**Row 5:** P10, 6 st RPC, C6F, 6 st LPC, p10.

**Row 6:** K10, p3, k3, p6, k3, p3, k10.

**Row 7:** P7, 6 st RPC, p3, k6, p3, 6 st LPC, p7.

**Row 8:** K7, p3, k6, p6, k6, p3, k7.

**Row 9:** P4, 6 st RPC, p6, k6, p6, 6 st LPC, p4.

**Row 10:** K4, p3, k9, p6, k9, p3, k4.

## Instructions

With 3.25mm needles, cast on 131[163] sts. Knit every row till work measures 5 cm, working an odd number of rows. Change to 4mm (UK 8) needles and work the following set up rows:

**Next row (RS):** K49[65], p4, k1, kfb, p9, (kfb) three times, p9, kfb, k1, p4, k49[65]. 136[168] sts.

**Next row:** K5, p44[60], k4, p3, k9, p6, k9, p3, k4, p44[60], k5.

Commence Pattern:

**Row 1 (RS):** K5, Bobble Pattern row 1 across 44[60] sts, Cable Panel row 1 across 38 sts, Bobble Pattern row 1 across 44[60] sts k5.

**Row 2:** K5, Bobble Pattern row 2 across 44[60] sts, Cable Panel row 2 across 38 sts, Bobble Pattern row 2 across 44[60] sts k5.

These 2 rows set the position of the pattern: 5 knit sts worked at both ends, the bobble pattern worked over 44[60] sts with the central 38 sts worked in the cable panel.

Cont in patt as set till work measures 60[85] cm, measured from the cast on edge, and ending with a WS row. Change to 3.25mm (UK 10) needles and knit every row for 5 cm, ending with a RS row. Cast off all sts on the WS.
