## Installation Instructions

- Make sure the bike is completely cool before starting the installation. Make sure the bike is secure on a centerstand or ideally a service lift.
- 2. Remove left and right side panels.
- 3. Remove Air Box mud flap screws.

Loosely install the newTwo Brothers Racing head pipe making sure that the original copper gasket is between the head pipe and cylinder head.



 Loosely attach the muffler to the S-Bend using the four 6x14mm Socket Head Cap Screws and 6mm split lock washers provided.

## Care & Cleaning

#### Care & Cleaning

Keep system free of dirt and moisture. Store in a cool, dry place. Make sure vehicle is completely cool before maintenance.

Stainless Header System: Polished stainless steel pipes will turn a light golden hue after a few heat cycles, this is a normal characteristic of high quality stainless steel. Clean using a mild water based spray cleaner. Always apply cleaner or polish with a soft, clean cloth.

Titanium Header System: Polished titanium pipes will experience color shift ranging from deep blue/purple through amber after a few heat cycles. This is a normal characteristic of high quality titanium. Clean using a mild water based spray cleaner. Always apply cleaner or polish with a soft, clean cloth.

Polished Aluminum Canisters: Use an aluminum or mag wheel polish to restore the bright finish to factory spec.

Brushed Aluminum Canisters: Clean using a mild water based spray cleaner. Always apply cleaner or polish with a soft, clean cloth.

Carbon Fiber Canisters: Clean using a mild water based spray cleaner. Always apply cleaner or polish with a soft, clean cloth. Always make sure the fiberglass packing inside is in good condition and not burned out, as exhaust heat inside an empty canister will deteriorate the carbon fiber sleeve. NEVER dyno test your bike with carbon fiber or titanium canisters installed - the intense heat and lack of cooling air can quickly burn through the canister material. Two Brothers Racing does not provide a warranty for burned canisters.

# Installation Instructions

- 10. Loosely attach muffler assembly to motorcycle using the supplied 8x30mm flange bolt and OEM mid-pipe mounting bolt.
- 11. Tightening sequence should be head pipe first, followed by the mid-pipe, then the four V.A.L.E.<sup>™</sup> ring muffler bolts, and lastly the muffler mount.
- 12. Install side panel bumper from OEM side panel and push into holder. Attach to muffler.





- 13. Reinstall side panels and mud flap.
- 14. Double check to make sure that all hardware is tightened.
- 15. Before you run the bike, clean off all fingerprints and dirt, as any oily residue will etch the metal and become somewhat permanent when the system gets hot. Run the bike and enjoy. It is normal for some white smoke to appear the first time you start the bike. This is packing/manufacturing oil from inside the pipe burning off. Check for gaps or leaks. If you find a leak, a little high temperature silicon sealant should fix it. After 50 to 100 miles, recheck all fasteners for tightness.
