1. Make sure the bike is completely cool before starting the

installation. Make sure the bike is secure on a

centerstand or ideally a service lift.
Remove the 6 bolts securing the endcap.

In order to maintain optimal performance it is recommended that this spark arrestor be cleaned after every 30 hours of use.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

We recommend that this performance part be installed by a qualified motorcycle technician. If you have any doubts as to your ability to install this performance part, please consult with your local motorcycle dealer. Read all instructions first before starting installation. Make sure the motorcycle and exhaust system are completely cool before starting the installation. Also, make sure the bike is secure on a centerstand or ideally a service lift during installation. Be sure to save all stock components for possible use later.



4. Remove spark arrestor screen.



5. Vigorously brush spark arrestor screen with a wire brush to remove accumulated residue.



- 6. After cleaning, replace screen and endcap. Securely tighten the six endcap retaining bolts.
- Before you run the bike, clean off all fingerprints and dirt, as any oily residue will etch the metal and become somewhat permanent when the system gets hot.
