





Installation Instructions

1. Remove OEM air filter assembly.







Remove OEM gaskets from back of air box to be used with TBR Comp-V.





 Remove rubber grommet and spacer and install on Comp-V backing plate.



- 4. Disassemble Comp-V to backing plate to ease installation.
- 5. Connect breather hose to barb on back of Comp-V plate.







6. When installing backing plate to throttle body be sure to tighten socket head screws evenly 1/4 turn at a time to ensure no binding. (Socket head screws are self locking and some slight resistance is normal when tightening.)





 Install TBR air filter and face plate. Tighten the four socket head cap screws.
