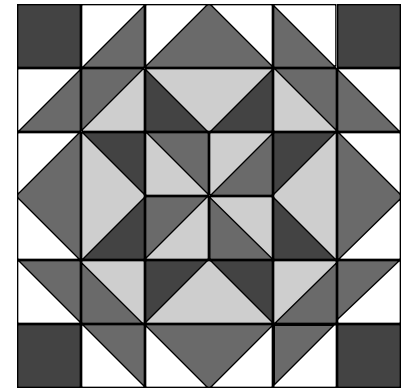


BLOCK ELEVEN

Cutting Directions:

- Background - Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
 Cut (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- Dk Purple (Color A) - Cut (12) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
 Lt Purple (Color B) - Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
 Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- Med Green (Color C) - Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
 Cut (8) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Sewing Directions:

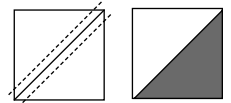
Step One: Following steps in General Directions and using (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Color C rectangle and (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Background squares sew a flying geese unit. Make (4) total.



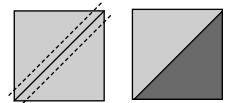
Step Two: Repeat Step One using (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Color B rectangle and (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Color A squares. Make (4) total.



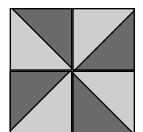
Step Three: Following steps in General Directions and using (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Color C squares and (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Background squares, sew half square triangle units. This will create eight units.



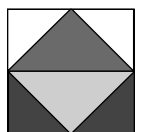
Step Four: Repeat Step Three using (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Color C squares and (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Color B squares. This will create eight units.




Step Five: Take four of the units made in Step Four and sew the center pinwheel block. Should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

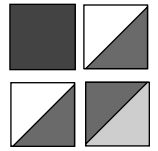


Step Six: Sew the flying geese units from Step One to the flying geese units from Step Two as shown. (Note orientation of units.) Make (4) total. Should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

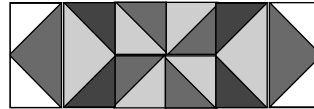




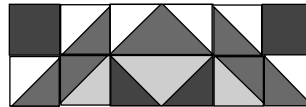
Step Seven: Create the corner four-patch units using (1) 2" Color A square, (2) units from Step Three and (1) unit from Step Four. Make (4) total. Should measure 4½" square.



Step Eight: Sew together the center row using the pinwheel block from Step Five and (2) flying geese units from Step Six. Should measure 4½" x 12½".



Step Nine: Sew together the top and bottom rows using (1) flying geese unit from Step Six and (2) corner units from Step Seven. Make (2) total. Should measure 4½" x 12½".



Step Ten: Sew the rows together (making sure to turn bottom row) to make the block shown on the first page. Should measure 12½" square.
