



Step Seven:


Using (1) half square unit sewn in Step Five, sew (2) Color A triangles to the light green side of the square. Then, sew (2) Background triangles to the top to finish out this unit. Make (4) total. Should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Step Eight:Sew together the units made in Step Four and Step Six to make a four
patch block. Then add the remaining background triangles to the sides to
complete the center square. Should measure 6½" square.



Step Nine: Make the center row of the block by sewing a Step Seven unit to each side of the center block you made in Step Eight.



Step Ten: Make the top and bottom rows of the block by sewing a four patch unit you made in Step Three to either side on a Step Seven unit. Make (2) total.



Step Eleven: Sew the rows together (making sure to turn the bottom row) to make the block shown above. Should measure 12½" square.

(Note: you will have two purple and two green triangles left unused for this block)
