

BLOCK FOUR

Many Different Blocks

Cutting Directions:

Background -

Cut (6) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut corner to corner once



Cut (2) 2" x 10" strips

Lt Purple (Color A) -

Cut (3) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut corner to corner twice



Cut (1) 2" x 10" strip

Med Green (Color B) -

Cut (2) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut corner to corner twice



Cut (1) 2" x 10" strip

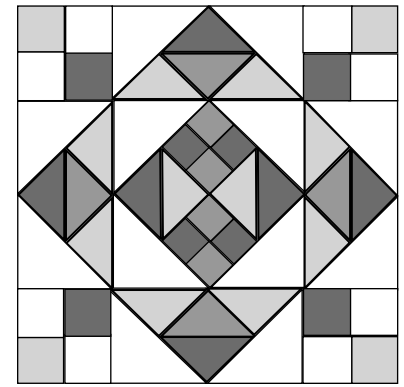
Cut (1) $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x 7" strip

Lt Green (Color C) -

Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square, cut corner to corner twice

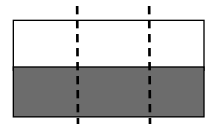


Cut (1) $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x 7" strip

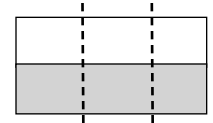


Sewing Directions:

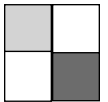
Step One: Sew together (1) 2" x 10" Color B strip and (1) 2" x 10" Background strip. Press toward Color B. Cut into (4) 2" lengths.



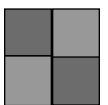
Step Two: Repeat Step One using (1) 2" x 10" Color A strip and (1) 2" x 10" Background strip. Press toward Color A. Cut into (4) 2" lengths.



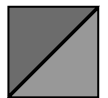
Step Three: Using (1) segment from Step One and (1) segment from Step Two sew a four patch unit. Make (4) total. Should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



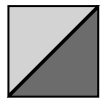
Step Four: Repeat Steps One through Three using $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x 7" strip Color B and $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x 7" strip Color C, and cutting the (4) segments into $1\frac{5}{8}$ ". Make (2) four patch units. Should measure $2\frac{5}{8}$ " square.




Step Five: Using (4) Color B and (4) Color C triangles, make four units as shown. Should measure $2\frac{5}{8}$ " square.

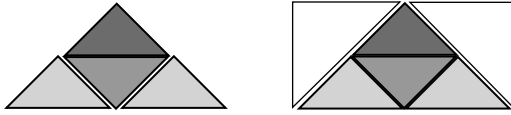


Step Six: Using (2) Color A and (2) Color B triangles, make two units as shown. Should measure $2\frac{5}{8}$ " square.

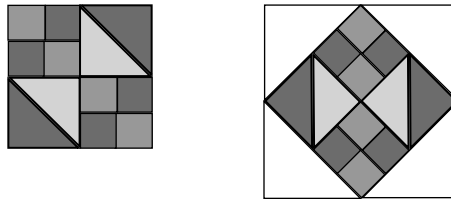




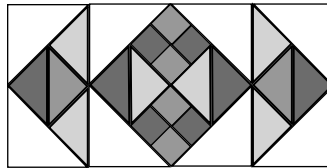
Step Seven: Using (1) half square unit sewn in Step Five, sew (2) Color A triangles to the light green side of the square. Then, sew (2) Background triangles to the top to finish out this unit. Make (4) total. Should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



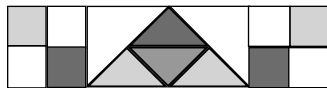
Step Eight: Sew together the units made in Step Four and Step Six to make a four patch block. Then add the remaining background triangles to the sides to complete the center square. Should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Step Nine: Make the center row of the block by sewing a Step Seven unit to each side of the center block you made in Step Eight.



Step Ten: Make the top and bottom rows of the block by sewing a four patch unit you made in Step Three to either side on a Step Seven unit. Make (2) total.



Step Eleven: Sew the rows together (making sure to turn the bottom row) to make the block shown above. Should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

(Note: you will have two purple and two green triangles left unused for this block)
