## licorice all-sorts steps



STEP ONE:

CUT SMALL STRIPS FROM EACH FELT SHEET, APPROX 2CM WIDE.



STEP THREE:

PAINT EACH FELT SQUARE WITH
A THICK LAYER OF GLUE



STEP FIVE:

REPEAT UNTIL YOU HAVE 10 LAYERS
GLUED TOGETHER. ALLOW UP TO 24HRS
FOR GLUE TO DRY COMPLETLY.



STEP TWO:

TRIM THE FELT STIPS INTO SMALL SQUARES THAT ARE 2CM X 2CM IN SIZE. EACH LICORICE ALL SORT NEEDS 10 SQUARES.



STEP FOUR:

EACH COLOUR LAYER CONSISTS OF 2 OF
THE SAME COLOUR GLUED TOGETHER TO GET
THE RIGHT THICKNESS, ALTERNATE COLOURS
AFTER 2 SQAURES OF EACH COLOUR.



STEP SIX:

IF SOME OF THE EDGES ARE OVERHANGING, TIDY
THESE UP BY TRIMMING WITH SHARP SCISSORS.
REPEAT FOR AS MANY ALLSORTS AS YOU LIKE



## licorice roll steps



STEP ONE:

CUT 2 RECTANGLES OUT OF FELT, THE OUTSIDE COLOUR (APPROX. 30 X 95MM) AND THE INSIDE COLOUR (APPROX. 30 X 45MM)



STEP TWO:

TIGHTLY ROLL THE SMALLER INSIDE PIECE OF FELT INTO A LOG SHAPE.



STEP THREE:

THEN ROLL THE SMALLER INNER PIECE INSIDE OF THE LARGE PIECE.



STEP FOUR:

SEW THE END AP DOWN ALONG THE LENGTH OF THE ROLL.



STEP FIVE:

REPEAT FOR AS MANY AS YOU WANT!



## wrapper lolly steps



STEP ONE:

CUT A RECTANGLE OUT OF COLOURED FELT
(APPROX. 60 X 95MM)



STEP TWO:

USING A SMALL SCRAP OF FELT, POP IT
NEAR THE MIDDLE AS STUFFNG




STEP THREE:

THEN ROLL UP THE FELT RECTANGLE,
KEEPING THE STUFFING IN THE MIDDLE



STEP FOUR:

SEW THE END FLAP DOWN ALONG
THE LENGTH OF THE ROLL



STEP FIVE:

SEW AROUND THE ROLL USING BIG STITCHES,
ABOVE THE STUFFING. PULL TIGHTLY TO
GATHER. WRAP THREAD TIGHTLY AROUND THE
GATHERING & TIE OFF. REPEAT FOR OTHER END.



STEP SIX:

OPTIONAL: YOU CAN FINISH THE EDGES OF THE WRAPPED LOLLY WITH A ZIG-ZAG CUT OR PINKING SHEARS.
