here's what you'll need:

- **1**. Sewing machine
- 2. Thread (choose a fun colour)
- 3. Iron
- 4. Ruler
- 5. Material scissors
- 6. Pencil
- 7. Material (in your favourite print)





step 1 Gather these goodies

step 2 Measure and mark out 2 napkins



step 3 Cut out all 4 using sharp material scissors



step 4 Fold back one edge of the material by 1cm and iron flat



step 6 Sew the edges down



step 7 Your napkins and placemats are finished!



(14.5 x 19cm each)

...plus 2 placemats (25 x 19cm)



step 5

Move clockwise around the material folding back each edge by 1cm and ironing flat as you go

- 5. 4 foam hair curlers
- 6. 14 x 12.5cm sponge cloth
- 7. White paint
- 8. Paint brush
- 9. 14 x 12.5cm bubble wrap
- 10. Hot glue gun
- 11. Ruler
- 12. Scalpel
- 13. Pencil
- 14. Scissors
- 15. Double sided tape



here's what you'll need:

- 1. Ice Cream Gift Tag Printout on 280gsm paper free download from
- 2. Scissors
- **3.** Double sided tape
- 4. Glue
- 5. Hole Punch
- 6. Pom Poms, Pipe Cleans, Paper Clips, Ribbons, Twine + Pens (various colours for your own personal touch and style)

step-by-step:

- **1.** Print out the Make Me Iconic printout on 250gsm paper. Always make sure to set your printer output settings to 'high' for the highest quality print
- 2. Cut around all the templates following the black lines. Try to be as accurate as possible as this will determine the quality of the finished product

- your gift tags and embellishing tags. Use double sided tape to underneath your embellishing tags to stick on top of your gift wrapped item. Add pipe cleaners instead of ribbon. Use a paper clip to attach a gift tag to a treat bag.

3. Where indicated, hole punch the shape in the corner on the smaller gift tags.

4. On the larger gifts tags using for embellishing gifts, add either glue or double sided tape and a green pom pom to the Bubble O Bills nose. This is optional, but adds a nice 3-dimensional touch to your gift wrap.

here's what you'll need:

- **1**. Fabric scissors
- 2. Black Texter
- 3. Ruler
- 4. Pinking shears
- 5. Pins
- 6. Sewing Machine
- 7. 4 x A4 brown Felt



step 1 Cut felt into below sizes: One x 7.5cm x 12.5

Two x 7.5cm x 18cm Two 12.5 x 18cm Two 30cm x 3cm



step 3

Once you've done that pin on your 7.5cm x 18cm pieces to each side to form the bag and sew the edges. Then turn the bag inside out.



step 4



step 2

Pin the two 12.5cm x 18cm pieces to the 7.5cm x 12.5 piece. Then sew them together about .5cm from the edge.



..because we are making this bag from felt there are no edges to finish off so it won't fray.

Then cut round the open top edge using pinking shears to create the zig zagged effect.




step 5 Now pin and sew on your handles.

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Now your children can go shopping and carry lots of little treats in their new bags.

- 1. Sculpey clay (57g packet in translucent)
- 2. Sculpey clay (57g packet in yellow)
- 3. Stanley knife

- 5. Oven
- 6. Baking tray
- 7. Baking paper
- 8. Stanley knife

and for the capsicum:

- 1. A4 piece of green felt
- 2. Material scissors
- 3. Texture Pins
- 4. Ruler
- 5. Glue gun

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tip —

Warm the clay up by rolling it into a ball in between your palms. The warmer the clay the easier it is to work with.





08 easter craft ideas, part 01 — EASTER JARS + **PAINTED EGGS**



here's what you'll need:

- 1. Any container with a removable lid
- 2. 2 x Air dry clay in different colours
- *3.* Make Me Iconic Aussie Animals

step-by-step..

- 1. Remove any rings as this clay can be suuuuper sticky. Open the first colour of clay and cover the entire lid.
- 2. Open the second packet of clay and create small balls or squiggles and strategically place them over the lid to create a pattern
- 3. Push any animal into the clay on the lid. Make sure you leave your new container high up out of the way of little fingers for at least 48 hours so it can dry.
