



What Scroll Saw Blade to Use???

It is important to maintain square cuts in order for Intarsia pieces to fit. There are so many variables from the scroll saw, which blade, to the lumber you are cutting. The easiest part of this equation is making sure your blade is square to the table. After that it can be a guessing game, the following information may help.

The most frequently asked question:

What scroll saw blade do I use?

I always hesitate to give a definitive answer because there are so many variables that can affect an accurate cut and the ability to stay square:

- Scroll Saw/Scroll Saw speed
- Wood Soft, Medium, Medium Hard, Hard or really Hard?
- · Thickness of Wood
- Density (how compact or concentrated.)
- Grain Tight, Loose?

For the tests, we used the Seyco Saw (4000 – 1600 RPM). Average saw speed was between 1400- 1550 RPM.

We gathered many different species of 7/8" thick wood from Western Red Cedar to 7/8" Blood Wood. Clear packing tape was placed on the hard to really hard woods.

We tested Platinum, Platinum Plus, Titanium, Titanium Reverse, and TLB blades from size #3 to #9.

The most significant finding:

If cuts are labored (sluggish), not staying square, don't automatically go up a blade size, try going down a size. Adjust your speed up or down. Give close attention to feed rate and avoid pushing. With the smaller blade size make sure you change your blade often. The narrow blade seems to move through the wood with less resistance.

I could consistently use a Titanium or Platinum Plus #3 for smooth square cuts.

I found that going up to a #9 presented some problems:

With the #9 blades I felt the need to push the wood into the blade. Which in turn caused more burning and the inability to follow the line with accuracy, causing the cuts to be out of square.

CT & CTP-22 "Willie" is the project for the 2018 Advanced class. I used basswood for the face, splated hackberry for the hair, red-heart for the bandana, and some thermally treated poplar (high-temperature thermal modification transforms the wood to very dark brown) for the shirt. The Classroom in a Tube includes detailed instructions and two sets of patterns already cut apart (*just add wood*). The CTP comes with just the pattern and a photo.

I-391 "Cat Grin" This pattern was inspired by a calander I got last year. I found a great premade frame, Ampersand Floater Frames, the maple frame is very nicely made and works perfect for these projects. You can search online to find the best price, 11 x 14 price \$32.00. I used two shades of blue pine, some off-white hackberry and a small piece of Spanish cedar for the nose, walnut for the dark parts. The cat would look great using any color of wood. I used basswood for the hand, aspen and thermally treated poplar for the paper smile. The hand and paper smile is glued to a backing and attached to the frame with magnets. The pattern has different smiles you can choose from.

I-392 "Chihuahua Smile" Same format as the cat. I used western red cedar for most of the dog parts, walnut for the eyes, aspen for the light parts. Basswood for the hand, aspen and thermally treated poplar for the paper smile. The pattern has different smiles you can choose from.

I-393 "Cheeky Bulldog" Same format as the cat. I used 2 shades of western red cedar for most of the dog parts, walnut for the eyes, aspen for the white parts. Basswood for the hand, aspen and thermally treated poplar for the paper smile. The pattern has different smiles you can choose from.

I-394 "Lab Surprise" Same format as the cat. I used walnut dog parts, walnut & aspen for the eyes, two shades of western red ceder and aspen for the blanket. Basswood for the hand, aspen and thermally treated poplar for the paper smile. The pattern has different smiles you can choose from.

II-21 "Superstition Mountain" I made this project in 2011 following a trip to AZ, the landscape inspired this piece. I used various shades of western red cedar for all of the mountain, aspen for the clouds and eagle, walnut for the dark parts of the eagle. I used walnut bark and hackberry for the lizzard. It is glued to a piece of maple veneer, which is the background. Included are instructions on putting the project together.













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

Kirges Inflatable Sanders · Use with the Foredom

To use the Kirges Inflatable Sanders you will need to purchase two 1/4 Collet Holders #CHA-5. We recommend mounting the #140 on the right and the #120 on the left of the bench lathe. *The Kirges K-130 will not fit the lathe.*

The Kirjes sanders are soft on the edges which makes getting into tight places without tearing up the rest of the piece much easier. These little sanders have saved me time when adding extra detail to my intarsia projects. The air is pumped in through the stem. Be sure to place the sanding sleeve over the edges of the black rubber bulb. I use a rougher grit on the K-120 (like a 80 grit) and a smoother grit on the K-140 (220 grit).

These mini wheels are very similar to the Wonder Wheel. The smaller size made it easier to see what I was doing. I was able to add much finer lines. The Mini Wheel does not replace the Wonder Wheel for texturing large areas. It wears down more quickly than the Wonder Wheel. I used a wheel dresser to sharpen the wheel to a "V".

"Wonder Wheel"



The Wonder Wheel can be used to add texture to all Intarsia projects. The wheel also darkens/burnishes dowels used for eyes. The Wonder Wheel is 6" in diameter x 1/2" wide with a 1" mounting hole. It fits on the shaft of a bench or pedestal grinder. Max R.P.M. is 4,500

The 1" mounting hole will need a reducer bushing (shown below) to fit on the shaft of the bench grinder motor.

U.S. Shipping Details

Pattern orders are rolled in mailing tubes to prevent folds and are shipped by US mail. Pattern shipping is \$8 - regardless of the amount of patterns ordered. Orders are normally shipped the same or next day after we receive them. US mail takes anywhere from 2 to 14 working days, depending on your location.

Hardware, books, and DVD shipping is \$8 to \$10, If ordering more than one, please refer to actual items in the catalog for additional shipping charges. One can of Old Masters gel is \$10 shipping, two to three cans - \$13, four cans - \$15, five cans - \$16. Depending on the quantity of any of these items ordered, they will be shipped either UPS or US mail. Pattern & hardware items, etc. shipped together will be \$14 & up depending on weight & destination. Poster/Patterns will be shipped separate from any hardware, books or DVD's. Two part shipping will be \$14 & up depending on weight and destination. If ordering large amounts of patterns and/or hardware items please call for shipping prices.

Canadian Shipping Details

Payment must be made in US funds, with international money orders or checks drawn on a US bank, or with a Visa, Mastercard, American Express, or Discover. Sorry, No postal money orders or personal checks.

Regular size pattern orders are rolled in mailing tubes to prevent folds, and shipped by US mail. Shipping price for 3 regular size patterns is \$11 - 4 or more is \$16, prices may vary for larger sizes and quantities. Orders are normally shipped the same or next day after we receive them.

Due to customs the mail can take from 2 to 8 weeks depending on your location. If ordering patterns along with books, DVD's and hardware items the charge will be from \$16 to \$25 (please call for shipping).

Scroll Saw Blade shipping is \$7.50 or they can be shipped together with patterns. When possible we will ship all items together. Shipping charges are subject to change depending on the weight and quantity of items ordered. Any items shipped UPS may have additional brokerage fees.



Beginner Class: Many students have suggested that we have more than three days for class. We added a half day on Tuesday from 1:00pm - 4:30pm. Full days Wed-Fri 9:00am - 4:30pm. All the wood, patterns, and supplies are provided. The class will cover basic skills required to get you started on the right foot with Intarsia. We will cover each step, using an easier pattern to help you to have a good understanding of this technique.

Intermediate Class: We will send you the patterns for the project along with a list of wood suggestions. We added a half day on Tuesday from 1:00pm - 4:30pm, Full days Wed-Fri 9:00am - 4:30pm. Cutting the project before class will allow more time to introduce multiple raising shims, shaping and adding texture to your project. Tuesday afternoon you will finish cutting some sections of the project, we will discuss any problems or questions about sawing. We suggest a minimum of 25 Intarsia projects completed before this class. If not, we suggest you make more projects before the class, or take the beginner class first.

Tuition \$545.00

Three & 1/2 Day Class: All classes will be held from Tuesday through Friday. This will be a "hands on" class. Tuesday class will be 1:00pm - 4:30pm, Wedensday-Friday class hours are 9:00am - 4:30pm with a 30 to 45 minute lunch break, we will provide lunches, refreshments, and snacks during the day.

Payments: To register for a class we require a \$200.00 deposit. Full payment for the tuition must be received two weeks prior to the beginning of your class. We ask that you notify us as soon as possible if you have a change of plans so that we can fill your class space. There will be a \$50 fee to transfer from one class to another. Class payments will not be transferred to future classes outside the current year's class schedule.

Refund And Cancelation Policy: To be eligible for any returned money, you must notify us as soon as possible. There will be an automatic \$50 cancellation fee for any canceled registration, regardless of the date of withdrawal. If you withdraw from a class more than 60 days in advance, the school will refund the deposit on the class, less the \$50 cancellation fee (refund of \$150.00). If you withdraw 30 to 59 days before the class, the school will refund only 50% of the deposit on the class, less the \$50 cancellation fee (refund of \$50.00).
