



- 2. Pin the base onto the bottom and stitch around the circular edge. Then turn rightside out.
- 3. To attach the pocket to the lining place pocket pieces rightside together and sew along the two sides and bottom, leaving the top edge open. Turn inside out and fold the top edges to the inside and stitch to secure the opening edge. Then attach the pocket to the lining along the bottom and two sides. Attach the base of the liner to the sides in the same way as in step 1 and 2. Turn so the right side is on the inside.





4. To make handles fold horizontally as shown in the pattern and stitch along the edge.



supplies and notes • 110 x 70 cm of canvas for outer • 110 x 70 cm of cotton for lining • thread • 110 cm lace for facing * In order to avoid shrinkage after sewing, soak fabric overnight and let it dry naturally. * The pattern does not indicate the seam allowances. Please add a 1cm seam allowance on each edge. * Cut 2 x side pieces, 2 x handle pieces, 1 x the base piece. For lining cut 2 x side pieces, 1 x base piece, 2 x pocket pieces. ••• Free downloadable pattern •••

5. To attach the facing stitch the two ends of the lace together to form a loop. Fold the top seam of the bag to the inside, and attach the handle as indicated on the pattern. Place the lining inside the bag and fold the top seam to the inside. Then sandwich the lace facing and handle between the inside and outside. Sew along the top edge to attach the handles and the facing. Secure with an extra row of stitching 1.5cm below from the first row.
