## I/WE (also referred to as the "Guarantor/s") UNCONDITIONALLY AND IRREVOCABLY:

- GUARANTEE the due and punctual payment to the Seller of all moneys which are now owing to the Seller by the Customer and all further sums of money from time to time owing to the Seller by the Customer in respect of goods and services supplied or to be supplied by the Seller to the Customer or any other liability of the Customer to the Seller, and the due observance and performance by the Customer of all its obligations contained or implied in any contract with the Seller, including but not limited to the Terms & Conditions of Trade signed by the Customer and annexed to this Guaranty and Indemnity. If for any reason the Customer does not pay any amount owing to the Seller the Guarantor will immediately on demand pay the relevant amount to the Seller. In consideration of the Seller agreeing to supply the Goods to the Customer, the Guarantor charges all of its right, title and interest (joint or several) in any land, realty or other assets capable of being charged, owned by the Guarantor now or in the future, to secure the performance by the Guarantor of its obligations under these terms and conditions (including, but not limited to, the payment of any money) and the Guarantor acknowledges that this personal guarantee and indemnity constitutes a security agreement for the purposes of the Personal Property Securities Act 1999 ("PPSA") and unequivocally consents to the Seller registering any interest so charged. The Guarantor irrevocably appoints the Seller and each director of the Seller as the Guarantor's true and lawful attorney/s to perform all necessary acts to give effect to this clause including, but not limited to, signing any document on the Guarantor's behalf which the Seller may reasonably require to:
  - (a) register a financing statement or financing change statement in relation to a security interest on the Person Property Securities Register;
  - register any other document required to be registered by the PPSA or any other law; or
  - correct a defect in a statement referred to in clause 1(a) or 1(b).
- HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the Seller on demand as a separate obligation against any liability (including but not limited to damages, costs, losses and legal fees calculated on a solicitor and own client basis incurred by, or assessed against, the Seller in connection with:

  - moneys paid by the Seller with the Customer's consent in settlement of a dispute that arises or results from a dispute between, the Seller, the Customer, and a third party or any combination thereof, over the supply of goods and/or services by the Seller to the Customer.

### I/WE FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE THAT

- I/We have received, read and understood the Seller's Terms and Conditions prior to entering into this Guarantee and Indemnity and agree to be bound by those Terms and Conditions.
- This Guarantee and Indemnity shall constitute an unconditional and continuing Guarantee and Indemnity and accordingly shall be irrevocable and remain in full force and effect until the whole of moneys owing to the Seller by the Customer and all obligations herein have been fully paid satisfied and performed.
- No granting of credit, extension of further credit, or granting of time and no waiver, indulgence or neglect to sue on the Seller's part (whether in respect of the Customer or any one or more of any other Guarantor(s) or otherwise) and no failure by any named Guarantor to properly execute this Guarantee and Indemnity shall impair or limit the liability under this Guarantee and Indemnity of any Guarantor. Without affecting the Customer's obligations to the Seller, each Guarantor shall be a principal debtor and liable to the Seller accordingly.
- If any payment received or recovered by the Seller is avoided by law such payment shall be deemed not to have discharged the liability of the Guarantor, and the Guarantor and the Seller shall each be restored to the position in which they would have been had no such payment been made.

## Project Floors (NZ) Limited - Terms & Conditions of Trade

### Definitions

- Definitions

  "Seller" shall mean Project Floors (NZ) Limited its successors and assigns or any person acting on behalf of and with the authority of Project Floors (NZ) Limited.

  "Customer" shall mean the Customer (or any person acting on behalf of and with the authority of the Customer) as described on any quotation, work authorisation or other form as provided by the Seller to the Customer. 12
- Customer. 
  "Guarantor" shall mean that person (or persons) who agrees to be liable for the debts of the Customer on a principal debtor basis. 
  "Goods" shall mean all Goods supplied by the Seller to the Customer (and where the context so permits shall include any supply of Services as hereinafter defined) and includes Goods described on any invoices, quotation, work authorisation or any other forms as provided by the Seller to the Customer Seller to the Seller Seller to the Customer.
- "Services" shall mean all services supplied by the Seller to the Customer and includes any advice or recommendations (and where the context so
- permits shall include any supply of Goods as defined above).
  "Price" shall mean the price payable for the Goods as agreed between the Seller and the Customer in accordance with clause 3 of this contract. 1.6

- Any instructions received by the Seller from the Customer for the supply of Goods and/or the Customer's acceptance of Goods supplied by the Seller shall constitute acceptance of the terms and conditions contained
- Where more than one Customer has entered into this agreement, the Customers shall be jointly and severally liable for all payments of the Price.
- Upon acceptance of these terms and conditions by the Customer the terms and conditions are binding and can only be amended with the written consent of the Seller. The Customer shall give the Seller not less than four
- written notice of any proposed change of ownership of the Customer or any change in the Customer's name and/or any other change in the Customer's details (including but not limited to, changes in the Customer's address, facsimile number, or business practice). The Customer shall be liable for any loss incurred by the Seller as a result of
- Customer shall be liable for any loss incurred by the Seiler as a result of the Customer's failure to comply with this clause. Goods are supplied by the Seller only on the terms and conditions of trade herein to the exclusion of anything to the contrary in the terms of the Customer's order notwithstanding that any such order is placed on terms that purport to override these terms and conditions of trade.

### Price And Payment

- Price And Payment
  At the Seller's sole discretion the Price shall be either:
  (a) as indicated on invoices provided by the Seller to the Customer in respect of Goods supplied; or (b) the Seller's quoted Price (subject to clause 3.2) which shall be binding upon the Seller provided that the Customer shall accept the Seller's quotation in writing within thirty (30) days.

  The Seller reserves the right to change the Price in the event of a variation to the Seller's quotation. Any variation from the plan of scheduled works or specifications (including, but not limited to, any variation due to fluctuations in the currency exchange rate, or due to unforeseen circumstances, or as a result of increases to the Seller in the cost of materials and labour) will be charged for on the basis of the cost of materials and labour) will be charged for on the basis of the Seller's quotation and will be shown as variations on the invoice. Payment for all variations must be made in full at their time of npletion.
- At the Seller's sole discretion a non-refundable deposit may be required.
- At the Seller's sole discretion:

  (a) payment shall be due before delivery of the Goods; or

  (b) payment for approved Customers shall be due twenty (20) days following the end of the month in which the Goods are invoiced to the Customer.
- Customer. Time for payment for the Goods shall be of the essence and will be stated on the invoice or any other forms. If no time is stated then payment shall be due seven (7) days following the date of the invoice. Payment will be made by cash, or by cheque, or by bank cheque, or by direct credit, or by any other method as agreed to between the Customer and the Seller. GST and other taxes and duties that may be applicable shall be added to the Price except when they are expressly included in the Price.

### **Delivery Of Goods**

- At the Seller's sole discretion delivery of the Goods shall take place
  - (a) the Customer takes possession of the Goods at the Seller's address;
  - (b) the Customer takes possession of the Goods at the Customer's nominated address (in the event that the Goods are delivered by the Seller or the Seller's nominated carrier); or

    (c) the Customer's nominated carrier takes possession of the Goods in

- (c) the Customer's nominated carrier takes possession of the Goods in which event the carrier shall be deemed to be the Customer's agent. At the Seller's sole discretion the costs of delivery are:

  (a) in addition to the Price; or

  (b) included in the Price; or

  (c) for the Customer's account.

  The Customer shall make all arrangements necessary to take delivery of the Goods whenever they are tendered for delivery. In the event that the Customer is unable to take delivery of the Goods as arranged then the Seller shall be entitled to charge a reasonable fee for redelivery. Delivery of the Goods to a third party nominated by the Customer is deemed to be delivery to the Customer for the purposes of this agreement.

  The Seller may deliver the Goods by separate instalments. Each
- 4.5 separate instalment shall be invoiced and paid for in accordance with the provisions in these terms and conditions.

  The failure of the Seller to deliver shall not entitle either party to treat this

- The latitude of the closure of the contract as repudiated.

  The Seller shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever due to failure by the Seller to deliver the Goods (or any of them) promptly or at all, where due to circumstances beyond the control of the Seller.

- Risk
  If the Seller retains ownership of the Goods nonetheless, all risk for the Goods passes to the Customer on delivery.
  If any of the Goods are damaged or destroyed following delivery but prior to ownership passing to the Customer, the Seller is entitled to receive all insurance proceeds payable for the Goods. The production of these terms and conditions by the Seller is sufficient evidence of the Seller's rights to receive the insurance proceeds without the need for any person dealing with the Seller to make further enquiries.

Unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the Seller, the Customer waives its right to receive a verification statement in accordance with section 148 of the PPSA.

  The Customer shall unconditionally ratify any actions taken by the Seller under clauses 7.1 to 7.5.

  Despite anything to the contrary contained herein or any other rights which the Seller may have howsoever:

### Customer's Disclaimer

Customer's Disclaimer

The Customer hereby disclaims any right to rescind, or cancel any contract with the Seller or to sue for damages or to claim restitution arising out of any inadvertent misrepresentation made to the Customer by the Seller and the Customer acknowledges that the Goods are bought relying solely upon the Customer's skill and judgment

Defects
The Customer shall inspect the Goods on delivery and shall within seven (7) days of delivery (time being of the essence) notify the Seller of any alleged defect, shortage in quantity, damage or failure to comply with the description or quote. The Customer shall afford the Seller an opportunity to inspect the Goods within a reasonable time following delivery if the Customer believes the Goods are defective in any way. If the Customer shall fail to comply with these provisions the Goods shall be presumed to be free from any defect or damage. For defective Goods, which the Seller has agreed in writing that the Customer is entitled to reject, the Seller's liability is limited to either (at the Seller's discretion) replacing the Goods or repairing the Goods. ### Returns

- - Returns will only be accepted provided that:
    (a) the Customer has complied with the provisions of clause 10.1; and
    (b) the Seller has agreed in writing to accept the return of the Goods; and (c) the Goods are returned at the Customer's cost within fourteen (14)

  (d) the Seller will not be liable for Goods which have not been stored or used in a proper manner; and
  (e) the Goods are returned in the condition in which they were delivered and with all packaging material, brochures and instruction material in as new condition as is reasonably possible in the circumstances.

  11.2 The Seller may (in its discretion) accept the return of Goods for credit but this may incur a handling fee of twenty-five percent (35%) of the value of the returned Goods plus any freight.

  11.3 Non-stocklist items or Goods made to the Customer's specifications are under no circumstances acceptable for credit or return.

  The Customer warrants that all designs or instructions to the Seller will not cause the Seller to infringe any patent, registered design or trademark in the execution of the Customer's order and the Customer agrees to indemnify the Seller against any action taken by a third party against the Seller in respect of any such infringement.

  The Customer agrees that the Seller may use any documents, designs, drawings or Goods created by the Seller for the purposes of advertising, marketing, or entry into any competition.

### Default & Consequences Of Default

- Interest on overdue invoices shall accrue daily from the date when payment becomes due, until the date of payment, at a rate of two and a half percent (2.5%) per calendar month (and at the Seller's sole discretion such interest shall compound monthly at such a rate) after as well as before any judgment.

  In the event that the Customer's payment is dishonoured for any reason
- the Customer shall be liable for any dishonour fees incurred by the
- Seller.

  If the Customer defaults in payment of any invoice when due, the Customer shall indemnify the Seller from and against all costs and disbursements incurred by the Seller in pursuing the debt including legal costs on a solicitor and own client basis and the Seller's collection agency costs.

  If any provision of these terms and conditions shall be invalid, void, illegal or unenforceable the validity, existence, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected, prejudiced or impaired. These terms and conditions and any contract to which they apply shall be governed by the laws of New Zealand and are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of New Zealand. The Seller shall be under no liability whatsoever to the Customer for any indirect and/or consequential loss and/or expense (including loss of profit) suffered by the Customer arising out of a breach by the Seller of these terms and conditions.

  In the event of any breach of this contract by the Seller the remedies of the Customer shall be limited to damages which under no circumstances shall exceed the Price of the Goods.

  The Customer shall not be entitled to set off against, or deduct from the Price, any sums owed or claimed to be owed to the Customer by the Seller not to withhold payment of any invoice because part of that invoice is in dispute. invoice is in dispute.

  The Seller may license or sub-contract all or any part of its rights and obligations without the Customer's consent.

  The Seller reserves the right to review these terms and conditions at any time. If, following any such review, there is to be any change to these terms and conditions, then that change will take effect from the date on which the Seller notifies the Customer of such change. Neither party shall be liable for any default due to any act of God, war, terrorism, strike, lock-out, industrial action, fire, flood, drought, storm or other event beyond the reasonable control of either party.

  The failure by the Seller to enforce any provision of these terms and conditions shall not be treated as a waiver of that provision, nor shall it affect the Seller's right to subsequently enforce that provision.
