2019 PRESERVATIVE FREE PINOT NOIR

McLAREN VALE / EDEN VALLEY



VINEYARD

A tough year with low winter rainfall and small fruit set followed by a dry spring and summer.

Vintage was early with fruit being picked in early February in McLaren vale. Fruit flavours developed well before sugar levels, the fruit had wonderful intensity and earthiness typical of Pinot. Eden Valley was similar with a small crop that provided beautiful intense Pinot Noir characteristics.

WINEMAKING

Both Pinot batches were cool fermented, with pump overs two to three times a day to extract the soft tannins and delicate flavours. Inoculated with MLF and pressed out a few days after sitting on skins for optimum balance. The wines were settled overnight before racking into a combination of French Oak and allowed to mature prior to bottling in August and September 2019.
