2019 PRESERVATIVE FREE ROSÉ

RIVERLAND/LANGHORNE CREEK



VINEYARD

The Mataro and Cinsaut fruit for the Rose was sourced from our Riverland vineyards 56% and the Chenin Blanc was sourced from our Langhorne Creek Vineyard.

The Langhorne Creek vines are light sandy loam, with some granite over clay. We purchased our Loxton vineyard in mid 2010. This vineyard consists of eight hectares of vines, the oldest of which, the Grenache and Mataro were planted shortly after World War II and a late 80's planting of Shiraz.

The 2019 vintage arrived on the back of very little winter rainfall and the Riverland experienced hot dry days allowing for good colour and flavour development in the Cinsaut. Our Langhorne Creek vineyard experienced one of the hottest days on record, yet the Chenin blanc thrived in the conditions and maintained lovely high natural acid. As a result we experienced little disease pressure and optimal growing conditions which allowed the vines to provided us with lovely clean, ripe fruit. The fruit for the 2019 Rose was sourced from our Loxton vineyard Cinsaut and Grenache and Moorook Mataro blended with Chenin Blanc from Langhorne Creek to give good acidity and structure to the wine.

WINEMAKING

Picking for the Rose started late February where the Cinsaut and Grenache were cold soaked for 24 hours before being pressed out and allowed to settle before blending and fermentation. The Chenin and Mataro followed and were both picked in early March. All parcels finished fermenting to dryness and being preservative free also went through MLF to dryness before being blended, stabilised and bottled in June 2019.
